For the sake of recording the whereabouts of all the old stained glass windows which where taken out of the two buildings . . mentioned above, we would like the information on when and how many where taken out and their whereabouts.

We would also hereby request earnestly to let us know of any such removals and keep us informed in the future of any changes regarding structures older than 60 years. As lawful custodians of

South Africa's heritage it is our duty to follow up on such matters.

Applications are made to this office with regard to the alterations or demolition of heritage sites in the Eastern Cape and permission is granted in form of a permit.
