Opportunity to appeal

If you wish to appeal against the decision, an appeal may be lodged in terms of the National Appeal Regulations, 2014, as amended. By Regulation 4 (1) (a), an Appellant must lodge the appeal with the appeal administrator and provide a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party (IAP) and any organ of state with an interest in the matter, within 20 days from the date on which the notification of the decision for an application for an environmental authorization was sent to the registered interested and affected parties.
