# GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE (REWORKED CONCEPT)



## PROJECT PURPOSE

To create a space (moment of contemplation) , by installing memorial seats made from found objects on the North Eastern corner of Murray's Harbour. The chosen space overlooks the 'tram tracks' that were one the Island in an earlier -- evoking a time when Murray's Harbour was a site of incarceration for the Xhosa Chiefs and other groups.

**Framing the landscape**

The objective of the installation is to place two (2) memorial benches made of found wood, steel and concrete in (2) locations of 10m2 each, with an interpretive text. The placement of benches and treatment of the earth around will create a unique purview of the Island, the harbour and the mainland.

## The invitation [experience]

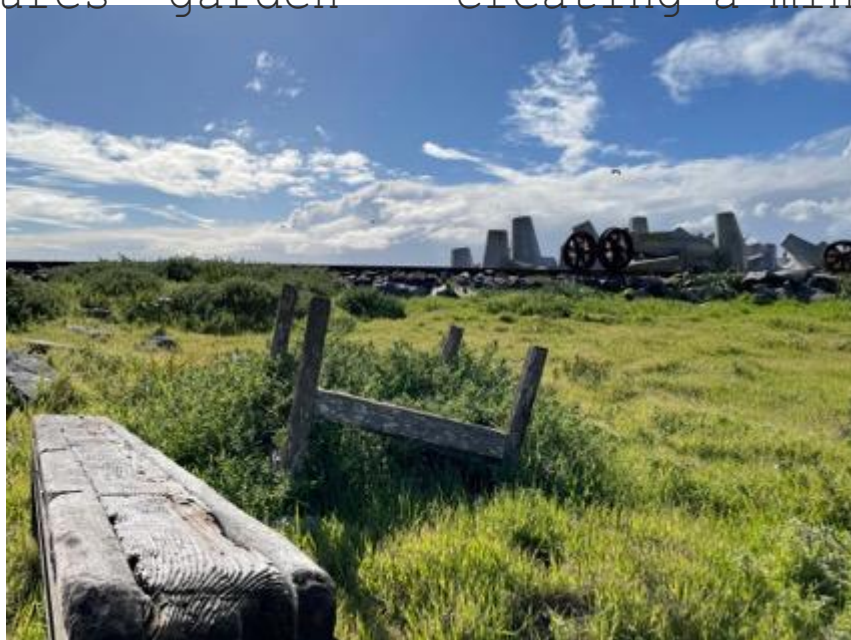

## Installation:

**Material:** Found wood, steel, objects and cement to create Memorial seating

We propose to use the Tram Tracks as a focal point. This now rusty track was functional in the period when some of the chiefs were incarcerated on Robben Island.
