MOTIVATION FOR PERMIT RENEWAL: STONE AGE HERITAGE SITE DESTRUCTION PLA 1677/S.35-027

Ivanplats would like to apply for the renewal of the permit for the destruction of the Iron Age Site PLA 1677/S.35-027 (Permit ID: 2503). The permit was issued to Ivanplats on 14 April 2021 with an expiry date of 30 April 2022. Engagements with families responsible for the graves located within the heritage site have taken longer than expected. Therefore, Ivanplats did not destruct the heritage site within time frame indicated on the destruction permit.

We would like to apply for the renewal of the permit to ensure that the heritage site PLA 1677/S.35-027 is destructed in accordance with the requirements of the National Heritage Act (Act 25, 1999). Negotiations and signing of agreements with family members whose graves are located within the heritage site continue. The heritage site will be partially destructed, under the supervision of Jaco van der Walt, a suitably trained and experienced archaeologist, leaving the prescribed buffer of 100 meters from any remaining graves. Once the agreements are reached with the family members, the graves will then be relocated in accordance with the SAHRA's requirements, and the site destruction finalised. A map showing the heritage site and a 100-meter buffer around the graves is attached for your reference.

Please be advised that the area for which permission for the partial site destruction is being sought, is required for development on the critical path of the Project. As such, this approach is imperative for the progress and success of the Platreef Project. We trust that the above meets with your approval.

This permit is issued to Mr Jaco van der Walt (Heritage Contracts and Archaeological Consulting) on behalf of Ms Jasmine Abrahams (Ivanplat), for the destruction of Iron Age/Historical Site Platreef PLA 1677/S.35-027, excluding the two discovered graves, located within the Operational Area of the Platreef Platinum Mine, Mokopane. SAHRA is satisfied with the interim permit report submitted by Mr Jaco van der Walt for the mitigation of Site PLA 1677/S.35-027.

- 1. Due to the potential of further graves in the area a watching brief must be undertaken by a trained archaeologist, with appropriate experience, during destruction of the site.
- Significant archaeological or historical finds recovered during the course of destruction activities shall be housed by the Polokwane Museum. In the case of graves appropriate arrangements must be made, including a separate permit application to SAHRA, for their re-internment.
- 3. The results of the watching brief must be submitted to SAHRA as part of the Final Permit Report on or before 30 April 2022.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and the excavator is responsible for ensuring that he or she has an understanding with the landowner concerning: the number of visitors and workers; conditions for camping on the property; speed limits on access roads; possible prohibitions on off-road driving; size, type and number of vehicles permitted; possible prohibitions on trespassing beyond the site; disturbing fauna, flora or substrate; erection and demolition of structures on the site; appropriate hours of visiting and working on the site; use of firewood, electricity and water; lighting fires and the prevention of uncontrolled fires and any fencing necessary to protect livestock. Conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 5. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
