All appeals should be accompanied by relevant supporting documentation.

The appellant must provide the applicant with a copy of the Notice of Intention to Appeal. The appellant must, in writing, show good cause should they require more time to lodge the Notice of Intent to Appeal or the Appeal. The appellant must lodge the Appeal within 30 days of lodging the Notice of Intention to Appeal on the official form, which can be obtained from the Department by contacting the Ministry on the above telephone number. Use of the official form on which to lodge the appeal is mandatory and failure to comply with this provision may result in the appeal being dismissed. The appeal form must be lodged with the following:

- a) A statement setting out the grounds of appeal;
- b) Supporting documentation referred to in the appeal which may not be in the possession of the Department or the MEC;
- c) A statement by the appellant that regulation 62(2) and (3) of the regulations have been complied with (i.e. Notice of Intent to Appeal was served on the relevant parties as set out above) together with copies of the notices in terms of the regulation (i.e. Notices of Intention to Appeal).
