

INTRODUCTION

In terms of the “principles for mine closure” in Regulation 56, the first principle states that the “closure of a mining operation is a process which must start at the commencement of mining and continue throughout the life of the operation”.

This document has been written so as to highlight the mitigation measures which did take place to resolve any applicable impacts which may have occurred during the life of the mine.

Rhenosterpan is licensed in terms of Prospecting Right 2232PR on portions 1 and 3 of Farm Rhenosterpan 316 LQ, Lephalale: Limpopo Region. The Environmental Management Plan was approved with specific Mining and Rehabilitation procedures for the site.

Take note that no prospecting activity has taken place on this site and the applicants wish to apply for closure certificate in terms of the newly promulgated Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act 28 of 2002.

1. CLOSURE PLAN

a) Description of closure objectives

The “closure objectives” have been determined from the approved Environmental Management Plan for the operation. The afore mentioned Environmental Management Plan was submitted and approved on the Departments standard Environmental Management Plan format.

The methods to achieve the closure objectives as can be ascertained from the standard Environmental Management Plan are as follows:

- To remove all infrastructure, equipment, plant, temporary housing and other items used during the mining period from the site.
- To remove waste material of any description, including receptacles, scrap, rubble and tyres from the site.
- To rip the area to a depth of 300mm to loosen the soil that was compacted by traffic and mining activities.
- To level and restore surface area of the site.
- To replace removed topsoil to a thickness of 200mm.
- To re-vegetate the mining area to reduce the chances of erosion.

b) Plan as contemplated in Regulation 2(2) of the regulations:

Refer to Plan. Attached as Figure 1.

c) Summary of regulatory requirements & conditions for closure:

There were no additional conditions set for the closure of the aggregate mine, above and beyond those contained in the approved Environmental Management Plan.

d) Summary of results of the environmental risk report:

As a result of no mining activity on either Portion 1 or 3 of the Farm Rhenosterpan 316 LQ, there were no results to be discussed in terms of the environmental risk report. The area remains untouched and therefore in the condition it was first found.

2. FINAL PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT

The Environmental Performance Assessment has been compiled in terms of Regulation 55 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (28/2002)

a. Aim of Environmental Performance Assessment:

An Environmental Performance Assessment is part of the closure requirements for the mining of aggregates on the relevant Portion 1 and 3 of the Farm Rhenosterpan 316 LQ. The aim of this Environmental Performance Assessment is merely to measure compliance with the approved Environmental Management Plan.

Due to the fact that no prospecting took place on the site at all, the site did not undergo any changes, and therefore no environmental risks or disturbance was caused. No Environmental Performance Assessment could therefore be done.

3. APPLICATION TO TRANSFER ENVIRONMENTAL LIABILITY TO COMPETENT PERSON

Paragraph 9c of the Application document requires an Application to Transfer Environmental Liability to a Competent Person.

This is not applicable in this instance.

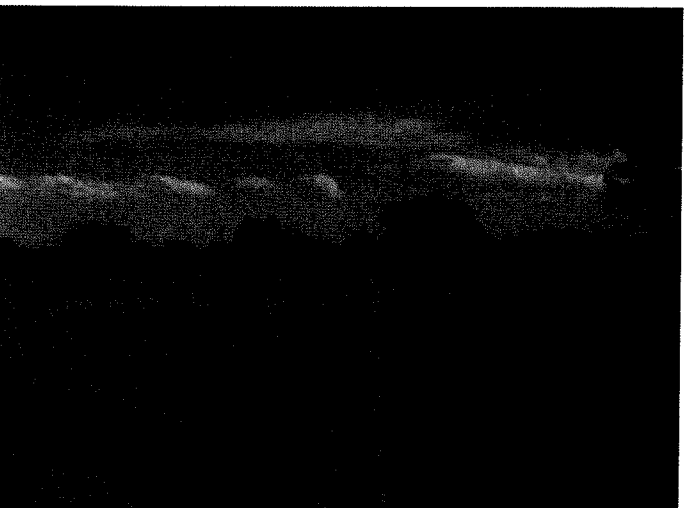
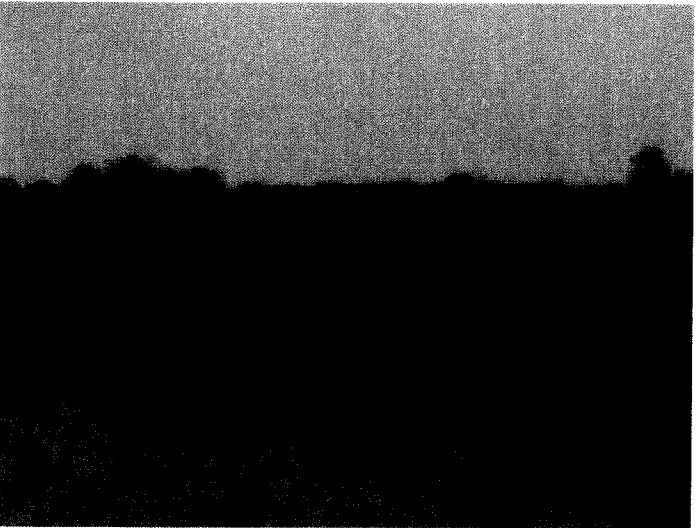
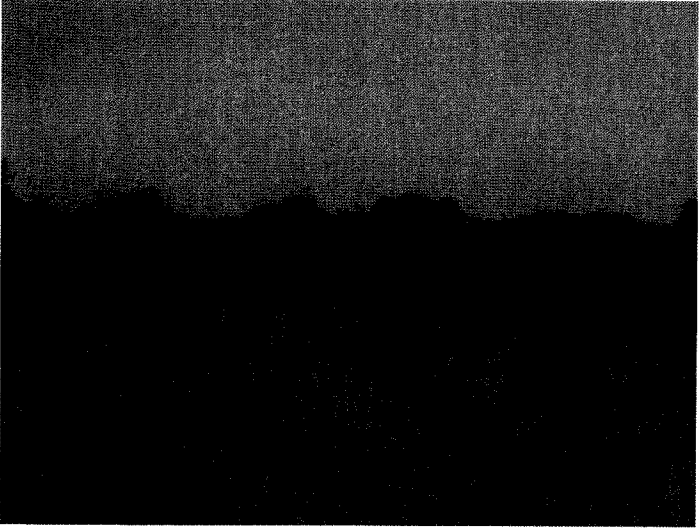
4. ENVIRONMENTAL RISK REPORT

It has been stated that the site, Portions 1 and 3 of the Farm Rhenosterpan 316 LQ, Lephalale: Limpopo, was intended for aggregate mining. No prospecting did however take place on the site as stipulated, and therefore no Environmental Risk report could be compiled. No activities took place on the site to cause any disturbance or cause harm to the environment. The site remains in its natural state as it was found.

5. CONCLUSION

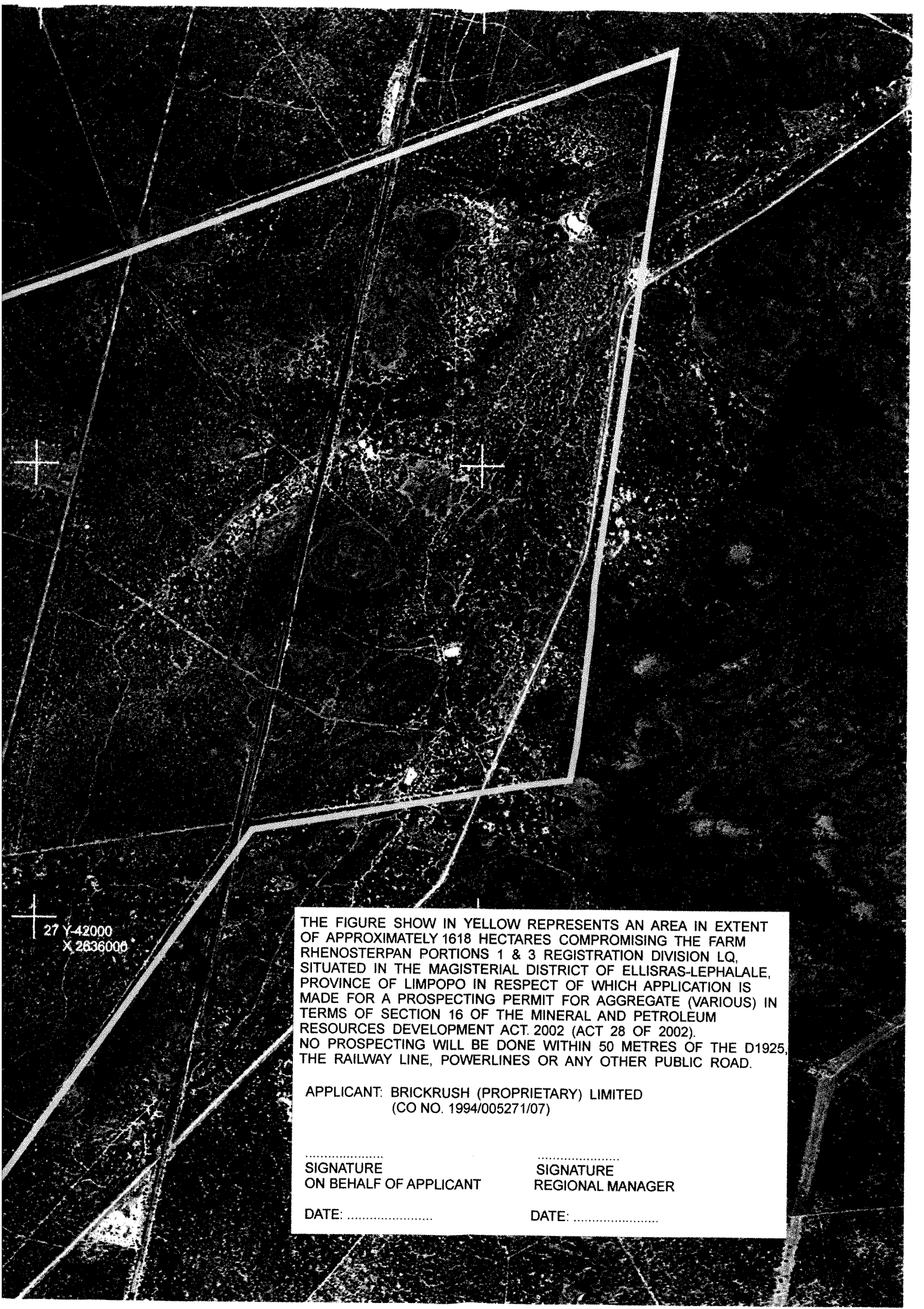

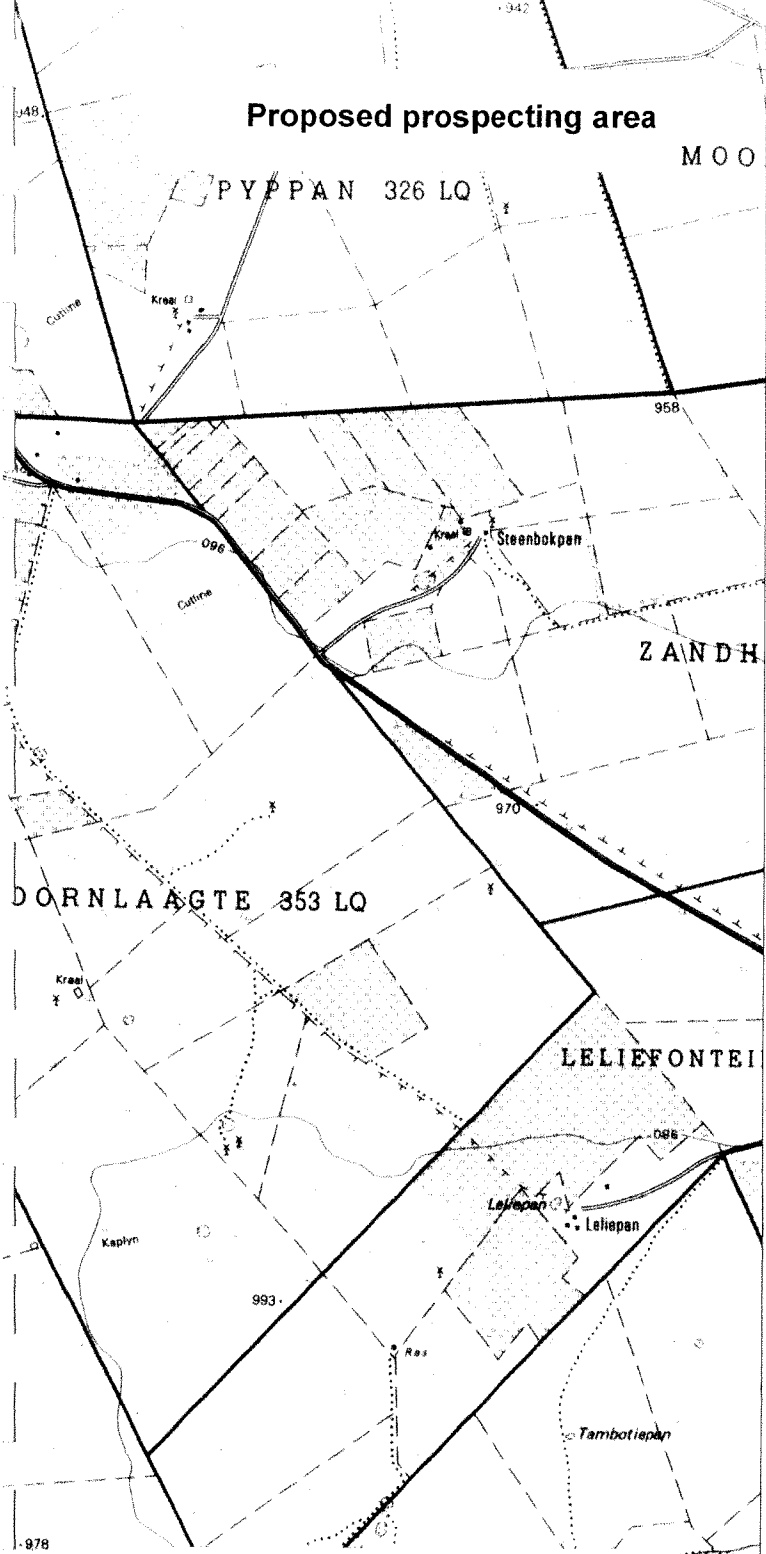
