URGENT REQUEST FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE REMAINS OF 58 GRAVES FROM THE FARMS BOSHMANSFONTEIN 12 IS, MPUMALANGA

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Our company has been appointed by Glencore South Africa (Pty) Ltd to affect the relocation of 58 graves located in a cemetery on the farm Boshmansfontein 12 IS, Mpumalanga.

DESCRIPTION OF CEMETERY

The details of this cemetery and graves are as follows:

Cemetery TOP 33

This cemetery is situated on the farm Boshmansfontein 12 IS near Ogies, Mpumalanga Province and contains 58 graves. The GPS Coordinates are 26° 3'6.81"S; 29°10'24.69"E. Currently these graves are located within an active mining pit and went unnoticed due to the overgrown vegetation and trees that surround them. Some of the graves are marked but there are no legible names on the graves. The cemetery was cleared with a bush cuter and the graves formally identified and numbered.

Despite the placement of site notices and an exhaustive social consultation process, no persons have come forward with any further information about who the next of kin are or how to contact them. Therefore, despite our exhaustive attempts to identify and contact the family, we have no further information regarding these graves, including sex, age at death, date of death and relocation cemetery. As per best practice, it is proposed that these 58 graves be relocated to the closest municipal cemetery, which is Kromdraai Cemetery.

LOCATION OF GRAVES

The cemeteries, which are affected by mining activities, are situated on the farm Boshmansfontein 12 IS (refer Annexure A) and are located in the Tweefontein Optimization Project (TOP) area at the following coordinates:

• TOP 33 - 26° 3'6.81"S; 29°10'24.69"E

PERMITS AND PERMISSIONS

We are also in the process of applying for permits and permissions from the following institutions:

- The Mpumalanga Provincial Department of Health. Note that we need a letter of permission from your office before we can submit this application.
- The South African Police Services were informed of the proposed relocation. They will be informed of the date of relocation at least 7 days in advance.

PROJECT INFORMATION

This cemetery is adversely impacted on by the expansion of coal mining by Glencore Coal. We have conducted an intensive process of social consultation in order to identify the buried individuals and to obtain requests for exhumation and re-interment from the affected families. This process commenced on Tuesday, 9 September 2014 with the erection of bilingual (English and isiZulu) site notices at the cemetery. Bilingual (isiZulu and English) newspaper notices were published in the Daily Sun on 6 August 2014 and Witbank News on Tuesday, 29 August 2014.

Extensive social consultation processes have been under way in the immediate mining area since November 2011. The methodology followed in terms of this consultative process comprised the following:

- Identification of persons who may have resided in the study area by speaking to elderly people who have lived within the surroundings of the study area all their lives.
- During conversations with these individuals leads may have been forthcoming of families or individuals who used to reside within the study area.
- Our social consultant followed up each of the leads, to ascertain whether these individuals could have graves buried within the study area.

As a result of the social consultation process the following results were achieved:

TOP 33
 Of the 58 graves located here, none have been positively identified or claimed by its next of kin.

Overall none of the total 58 graves have been positively identified by the affected families. The low identification rate can be ascribed to the age of the affected cemeteries and the fact that most of the affected families moved out of the area in the 1970's.

To clarify matters we have allocated the affected graves to the following categories:

REBURIAL OF REMAINS

It would be preferred that the unidentified graves be reburied in the closest municipal cemetery, which is Kromdraai Municipal Cemetery.

REQUEST

In light of the aforementioned information we hereby respectfully apply for permission to:

- 1. Exhume the remains in the 58 affected graves;
- 2. Rebury the remains in the cemeteries as set out above.

Martins Funerals (Emalahleni) will be responsible for the handling and reburial of the exhumed human remains.
