**NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM COMPLYING WITH REGULATION 56(4) OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE R.543 OF 2010, FOR THE PROPOSED FUEL DEPOT EXPANSION PROJECT FOR THE ANGLO AMERICAN PLATINUM LIMITED – MOGALAKWENA MINE**

Regulation 56(4) of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (R.543 of 2010) states that:

*Registered interested and affected parties (are) entitled to comment on submissions*

*(4) The draft versions of reports referred to in sub-regulation (3) must be submitted to the competent authority prior to awarding registered interested and affected parties an opportunity to comment.*

You are hereby notified that the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (LEDET) has granted Shangoni Management Services exemption from submitting a Draft Basic Assessment report for review to Interested and Affected Parties and stakeholders [Regulation 56(4)] for the following proposed project:

**Applicant:** Anglo American Platinum Limited – Mogalakwena Mine

**Project Name:** Fuel Depot Expansion for the Anglo American Platinum Limited – Mogalakwena Mine

**Date of decision:** 9 September 2014

In accordance with Chapter 7 of the EIA regulations, 2010, should you wish to appeal any aspect of the decision of granting the exemption, you must, *inter alia*, lodge a notice of intention to appeal

with the MEC for the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism, within 20 days after the date of the decision, by means of one of the following methods:

- By facsimile: 015 295 5015;
- By post: Private Bag X9484, Polokwane, 0700; or
- By hand: Environmental Affairs Offices (LEDET), Corner Suid & Dorp Streets, Polokwane, 0699.

The expiry date for the notice of intention to appeal to be submitted to LEDET is **30 September 2014**. In the event of appealing, you must provide the applicant, Anglo American Platinum Limited – Mogalakwena Mine, within ten (10) days of having lodged the notice of intention to appeal, with a copy of the notice of intention to appeal and a notice indicating where and for what period the appeal submission will be available for inspection by the applicant. The MEC may, in writing, on good cause extend the period within which a notice of intention to appeal must be submitted.

The appeal must be lodged with the appeal authority within thirty (30) days of the lapsing of the twenty (20) days after the date of the decision. The appeal must be submitted in writing and accompanied by:

- A statement setting out the grounds of the appeal;
- Supporting documentation which is referred to in the appeal and which is not in the possession of the MEC;
- A statement by the appellant that the notice of intention to appeal has been compiled;
- Copies of the notice of intention to appeal; and
- The prescribed appeal fee, if any.
