**NOTICE OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE ISSUED: AFGRI  
ANIMAL FEEDS DRYDEN RENDERING FACILITY: WASTE  
MANAGEMENT LICENCE APPLICATION**

Please note that there was a typing error in our previous letter regarding the expiry date of the submission of the appeal. The correct expiry date is the 25<sup>th</sup> of September 2015. We are hereby re-sending the notification letters with the correct expiry date.

You are hereby notified that the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) has decided to grant a Waste Management Licence for the above mentioned project in terms of the powers vested in it by the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2010. The decision to grant the Waste Management Licence was signed by the DEA on the 24<sup>th</sup> of August 2015 and issued on the 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2015. In terms of regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, all registered interested and affected parties must be notified within 14 calendar days of the Department's decision in respect of this Waste Management Licence Application as well as the provisions regarding the making of appeals that are provided for in the regulations.

In accordance with Chapter 2 of the National Appeal Regulations (Government Notice No. R. 993 of 8 December 2014), should you wish to appeal any aspect of the decision of granting the Waste Management Licence, you must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator for the National Department of Environmental Affairs, and a copy of the appeal must be submitted to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter, within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision of an application for an environmental authorisation or a waste management licence was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant. In other words, **within 20 days from the date**

**of this letter**, by means of one of the following methods, for the attention of The Minister, Department of Environmental Affairs:

The expiry date for the submission of the appeal to the DEA is therefore **25 September 2015**.

2. Accompanied by-
  - A completed Appeal and Response Form setting out the grounds of the appeal; and
  - Supporting documentation that is referred to in the appeal submission which did not form part of the documentation considered when the original decision was made.
