**NOTIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE: GOLDI FARM COMPOSTING SITE (AS PART OF THE RECTIFICATION OF UNLAWFUL COMMENCEMENT AND CONTINUATION OF A LISTED ACTIVITY IN TERMS OF SECTION 24(G) OF NEMA, 1998, AS AMENDED)**

You are hereby notified that the Mpumalanga Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Land and Environmental Affairs (MDARDLEA) has decided to grant a Waste Management Licence for the above mentioned project in terms of the powers vested in it by the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008), as amended, and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended. The decision on the Waste Management Licence was signed on the 11<sup>th</sup> of July 2016 and issued on the 12<sup>th</sup> of July 2016. All registered interested and affected parties must be notified, in writing and within ten (10) days, of receiving the Department's decision in respect of this Waste Management Licence Applications as well as the provisions regarding the making of appeals that are provided for the regulations.

In accordance with Chapter 2 of the National Appeal Regulations, 2014, should you wish to appeal any aspect of the decision of granting the Waste Management Licence, you must submit the appeal to the Member of the Executive Council of the Mpumalanga Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Land and Environmental Affairs, and a copy of the appeal must be submitted to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision for an application for an environmental authorisation was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant. In other words, within **20 days from the date of this letter** by means of one of the following methods:

- By facsimile: 013 766 8295;
- By post: Private Bag X11219, Nelspruit 1200; or

- By hand: Building 6, No 7 Government Boulevard, Riverside Park, Nelspruit, 1200.

The expiry date for the submission of the appeal to be submitted to MDARDLEA is therefore **12 August 2016.**

The appeal submission must be-

1. Submitted in writing on an official form obtainable or published by the relevant department;
2. Accompanied by:
  - a. A statement setting out the grounds of appeal;
  - b. Supporting documentation which is referred to in the appeal and is not available to the relevant Competent Authority;
  - c. A statement that the appellant has complied with regulation 62(2) or (3) together with copies of the notices referred to in regulation 62; and
  - d. The prescribed appeal fee, if any.
