Attached please find a copy of the Draft Basic Assessment (BA) Report and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) for the proposed construction of new lighthouse in Port Nolloth, Northern Cape. In terms of GN R 544, 545 and 546 promulgated under Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) published in *Government Gazette 33306* on 18 June 2010, the need for a Basic Assessment process was triggered by the inclusion of activities listed in GN R 544: Activity 18(iv). The original application submitted to the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) also listed activity 16(iii), (iv), iii: (cc), relating a development with a footprint greater than 10 square metres encroaching within 32 metres of a watercourse. Subsequent to undertaking the mandatory site visit and preparing this Draft BA it was found that no watercourses occurred within 32 metres of the proposed lighthouse development site. Therefore the listed activity (i.e. GN R 546: Activity 16(iii), (iv), iii: (cc)) has not been assessed in this Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR). A new application form reflecting this change has been submitted to the National DEA for acceptance.

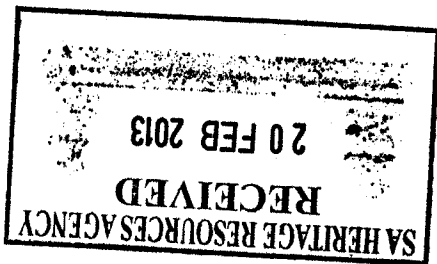

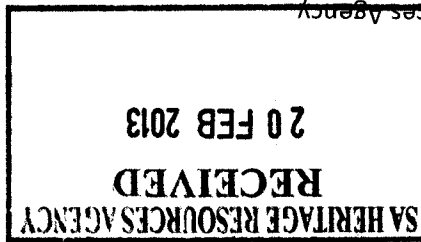

**DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT AND EMPR**

Attached please find a copy of the Draft Basic Assessment (BA) Report and Environmental Management Programme (EMPR) for the proposed construction of new lighthouse in Port Nolloth, Northern Cape.

In terms of GN R 544, 545 and 546 promulgated under Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) published in *Government Gazette 33306* on 18 June 2010, the need for a Basic Assessment process was triggered by the inclusion of activities listed in GN R 544: Activity 18(iv). The original application submitted to the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) also listed activity 16(iii), (iv), iii: (cc), relating a development with a footprint greater than 10 square metres encroaching within 32 metres of a watercourse. Subsequent to undertaking the mandatory site visit and preparing this Draft BAR it was found that no watercourses occurred within 32 metres of the proposed lighthouse development site. Therefore the listed activity (i.e. GN R 546: Activity 16(iii), (iv), iii: (cc)) has not been assessed in this Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR).
