NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

Phakwe Richards Bay Gas Power 3 (Pty) Ltd (PRBGP3) proposes the development of a combined cycle (CC) gas to power plant, with a capacity of up to 2 000MW, on various erven within the Richards Bay IDZ Phase 1F, Richards Bay. The proposed project is to be known as the Phakwe Richards Bay Gas Power 3 CCPP. The project site is located approximately 5km north-east of Richards Bay and 1km north of the suburb of Alton, within the jurisdiction of the City of uMhlatuze Local Municipality and the King Cetshwayo District Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal Province. The power plant will operate at mid-merit to baseload duty and will include the following main infrastructure:

- » A number of gas turbines for the generation of electricity through the use of natural gas (liquid or gas forms), or a mixture of Natural gas and Hydrogen (in a proportion scaling up from 20% H2) as fuel source, operating all turbines at mid-merit or baseload (estimated 16 to 24 hours daily operation).
- » Exhaust stacks associated with each gas turbine.
- » A number of Heat Recovery Steam Generator (HRSG) to generate steam by capturing the heat from the turbine exhaust.
- » A number of steam turbines to generate additional electricity by means of the steam generated by the HRSG.
- » The water treatment plant will demineralise incoming water from municipal or similar supply to the gas turbine and steam cycle requirements. The water treatment plant will produce two parts demineralised water and reject one-part brine, which will be discharged to the R IDZ stormwater system.
- » Steam turbine water system will be a closed cycle with air cooled condensers. Make-up water will be required to replace blow down.
- » Air cooled condensers to condensate used steam from the steam turbine.
- » Compressed air station to supply service and process air. Water pipelines and water tanks for storage and distributing of process water. (Potential sourcing of alternative water outside RB IDZ supply (Municipality)).
- » Water retention pond.
- » Closed Fin-fan coolers to cool lubrication oil for the gas turbines.

- » Gas generator Lubrication Oil System.
- » Gas pipeline supply conditioning process facility. Please note, gas supply will be via dedicated pipeline from the proposed Transnet supply pipeline network of Richards Bay (the location of this network has not yet been confirmed) or, alternatively directly from the Regasification facilities at RB Harbour. The gas pipeline will be separately authorized.
- » Site water facilities including potable water, storm water, wastewater.
- » Fire water (FW) storage and FW system.
- » Diesel emergency generator for start-up operation.
- » Onsite fuel conditioning including heating system.
- » All underground services: This includes stormwater and wastewater.
- » Ancillary infrastructure.
- » Electrical facilities.
- » Service infrastructure.



I refer to your invitation to comment on the Pienaarspoort Wind Energy Facility. I will be as brief as possible.

My response is not to dispute the benefits of renewable energy or to object to the construction of this facility. However, I object to the negative visual impact that the new structures will have on our area based on the present visual impact from the Perdekraal East facility.

I am a landowner residing against the slopes of the Waterfall Mountain (part of the Swartruggens mountain range) to the west of the new facility. The adverse visual impact, especially at night, from the Perdekraal facility, has been enormous. The impact of the Pienaarspoort development will have the same effect.

This area is unique for its endless views and stunning night skies, all within a couple of hours from Cape Town, a feeder of tourists to this area.

Many landowners in my area recognised the tourist potential of this unique area and invested heavily to develop their properties to accommodate both local and overseas visitors. The negative impact of this development on these businesses and resultant job losses are inevitable if their concerns are not addressed. I have stopped any future development on my property for the time being to avoid a similar fate.

These unsightly structures, with their myriad flashing red lights at night, have ruined the beauty of this very special place. I do, however, believe that there is a workable solution to minimise some of these negative impacts.

My concerns are, firstly and most importantly, the flashing red lights at night. I fully understand that you have to comply with our strict aviation regulations but there are solutions which I am sure you are aware of that are widely used in other countries that will overcome this problem. Dealing with this hindrance is crucial.

A second concern is the visual impact when the sun is reflected off the white surfaces of these towers. When the towers are in the shade of a passing cloud they are hardly detectable. As soon as they are in the sun they are extremely bright and visible. My property is 35 km from Perdekraal and the towers are clearly visible from here. A neutral colour matching the surrounding Karoo landscape would make them less noticeable. I would imagine that task would only be possible with new structures before assembly.

I sincerely hope that these issues are dealt with to lessen the negative effect these towers are having on this unique and yet unspoiled area.

The project is currently in the scoping phase of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and the 30-day commenting period to submit comments on the Scoping Report is ending on Monday, 13 December 2021.

The public information regarding the proposed project is available in the attached Background Information Document (attached for ease of reference) and more details and technical aspects are available in the Scoping Report that can be downloaded from our website <https://savannahsa.com/public-documents/energy-generation/prbgp3-2000mw-ccpp/> and the release code is BbTvP7gD

It is estimated that during the construction period the construction staff complement will be ~600 people, with peaks of staff higher, with employment opportunities being provided for the local community as far as possible. The labour required includes 90% low skilled and semi-skilled and a 10% of skilled and highly skilled workforce. At the completion of the construction period all construction staff will leave the site and will be replaced by the operating staff. Up to 60 people are required for the operation phase, with up to 70% of labour to be sourced from the local community. The degree to which local labour can be used for this purpose will, however, be dependent on the skills available locally, as well as the requirement for specialist resources used by contractors.

Fuel will be natural gas with the view to include green hydrogen in the fuel mix in the future once available. The amount of fuel to be consumed will depend on the degree to which the plant is used, as it is proposed to operate on either a mid-merit or baseload basis. The maximum fuel consumption of the power plant will be approximately 116 million GJ per annum at base load and 77 million GJ per annum at mid-merit. The estimated volumes of fuel required are: 3 021 000 000m³ at base load and 2 014 000 000 m³ at mid-merit. The source of fuel is expected to be the Transnet dedicated LNG pipeline, from the Richards Bay harbour, although the details regarding the proposed pipeline are not confirmed at this stage. Alternatively, fuel can be purchased from international suppliers. Where fuel is purchased from a party other than Transnet, it will be supplied to the power plant also via a dedicated gas pipeline, also from the Richards Bay harbour.

The footprint of the proposed plant would be up to 11Ha.

The project is currently in the scoping phase which includes the identification and description of potential issues. Detailed environmental studies will ~~only~~ be undertaken once the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) accepts the final Scoping Report and approves the Plan of Study for EIA.
