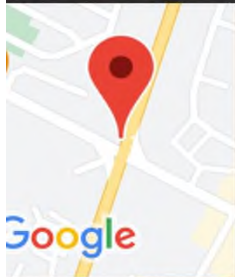

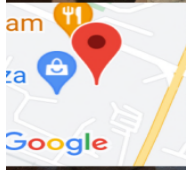
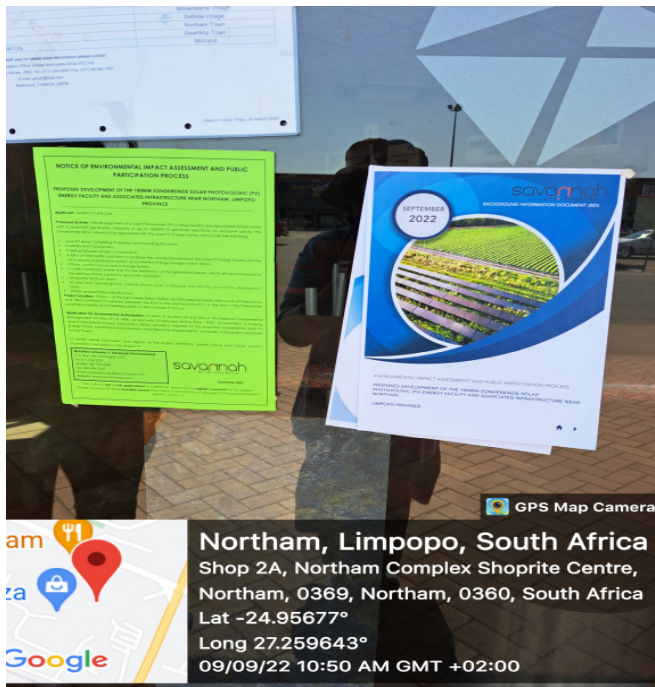

Site 1 – Corner R510 and Brits Road Northam

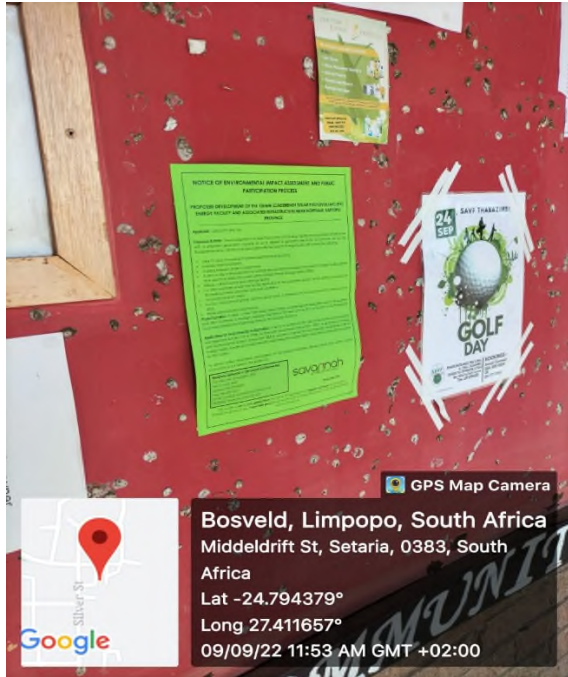
