Letsatsi PV (Pty) Ltd proposes the development of a solar photovoltaic (PV) energy facility with a generating capacity of up to 100MW. The proposed project is located on Portion 1 of the Farm Kopje Alleen 422KQ, approximately 30km south of Thabazimbi and 18km northeast of Northam, between the R510 in the west and the R511 in the east, in the Thabazimbi Local Municipality and Waterberg District in the Limpopo Province.

The nature and extent of the solar PV facility is explored in more detail in this Background Information Document (BID). A full Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting (S&EIR) process is being undertaken to obtain Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the development of the PV energy facility and associated infrastructure. The public participation process provides the public with an opportunity to comment on the project.

The infrastructure associated with the 100MW Zondereinde solar PV facility will include:

- » Solar PV array, with branch strings, comprising PV panels and mounting structures.
- » Inverters and transformers.
- » Underground cabling between project components.
- » A 33kV on-site facility substation to facilitate the connection between the Solar PV Energy Facility and the mine electrical distribution system and a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS).
- » Offices, control room/s and a storage facility.
- » 2 x 33kV overhead power line and transmission towers from the PV Site for the distribution of the generated power, which will be connected to the existing Smelter substation and Shaft substation (Existing 33kV Mine Substations).
- » Temporary laydown areas and a construction yard.
- » Access road (gravel), internal gravel roads, a firebreak and fencing around the PV site.

- » Water and sanitation infrastructure.
- » Security and access control

Additional technical information regarding this Solar PV facility is available in the Background Information Document attached to this notification letter.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS

In accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), the applicant requires Environmental Authorisation from the National Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries Limpopo Development of Economic Development, Environment & Tourism (LDEDET), as the Competent Authority. In terms of Section 24(5) of NEMA, the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended) and Listing Notices (GNR 327, GNR 325, and GNR 324), the application for EA is subject to the completion of a Scoping/EIA process. The application is required to be supported by comprehensive, independent environmental studies undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended).

The EIA is an effective planning and decision-making tool. It allows for potential environmental consequences resulting from a proposed activity to be identified and appropriately managed during the construction, operation, and decommissioning phases of development. It also provides an opportunity for the project applicants to be forewarned of potential environmental issues and allows for the resolution of impacts identified and reported on as part of the EIA process, as well as provides opportunity for dialogue with key stakeholders and Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs).

Savannah Environmental has been appointed as the independent environmental consultant responsible for managing the application for EA and undertaking the supporting EIA process required to identify and assess potential environmental impacts associated with the project, as well as propose appropriate mitigation and management measures to be contained within the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). I&APs will be actively involved in the EIA process through the public participation process.

You and/or the Department/Organization/Company, which you represent, have been identified as a stakeholder for the proposed project as described above. The nature and extent of the solar PV, associated infrastructure and the EGI, are explored in more detail in the BID which is attached to this letter and is also available for download from the Savannah Environmental website <https://savannahsa.com/public-documents/energy-generation/zondereinde-solar-pv/>
