

COMMENTS AND RESPONSES REPORT

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The Scoping phase of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Process for the Wagt Solar PV1 was announced together with the Pixley Cluster of Renewable Energy Facilities located near De Aar, Northern Cape Province on Friday, 25 March 2022. The Background Information Document was distributed together with a notification letter which served to invite Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to register their interest in the project and to submit any comments / queries that they might have on any one of the proposed developments or all. All written comments received during the Scoping Phase of the EIA process to date have been included in the table below and in **Appendix C7** of the Scoping Report.

The Scoping Report is available for a 30-day review and comment period from **Monday**, **11 April 2022** until **Monday**, **16 May 2022**. The Comments and Responses Report (C&RR) will be updated with comments received during the review and comment period and included in **Appendix C7** of the final Scoping Report.
