

The applicants Carolus Solar PV1 (Pty) Ltd, Fountain Solar PV1 (Pty) Ltd, Riet Fountain Solar PV1 (Pty) Ltd, and Wagt Solar PV1 (Pty) Ltd propose the development of a cluster of renewable energy facilities and associated infrastructure, including Electrical Grid Infrastructure (EGI), ~10km east of the town of De Aar in the Northern Cape Province. The cluster will be known as the Pixley Park and will consist of two (2) up to 120MW solar photovoltaic (PV) energy facilities and two (2) up to 250MW. The grid connection infrastructure for all projects will connect to the proposed new Wag 'n Bietjie Main Transmission Substation (MTS).

Each renewable energy facility will be constructed as a separate stand-alone project and therefore, separate Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) processes will be undertaken for each of the renewable energy facilities. Similarly, the grid connection solution will be subjected to separate Basic Assessment (BA) processes which will consider feasible alternatives for the power line corridors.





In terms of Section 24(5) of NEMA, the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended) and Listing Notices (GNR 327, GNR 325, and GNR 324), the five (5) applications for EA for the renewable energy facilities are subject to the completion of Scoping/EIA processes, and that for the Electrical Grid Infrastructures (EGIs) are subject to the completion of a BA process. Each application is required to be supported by comprehensive, independent environmental studies undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended).
