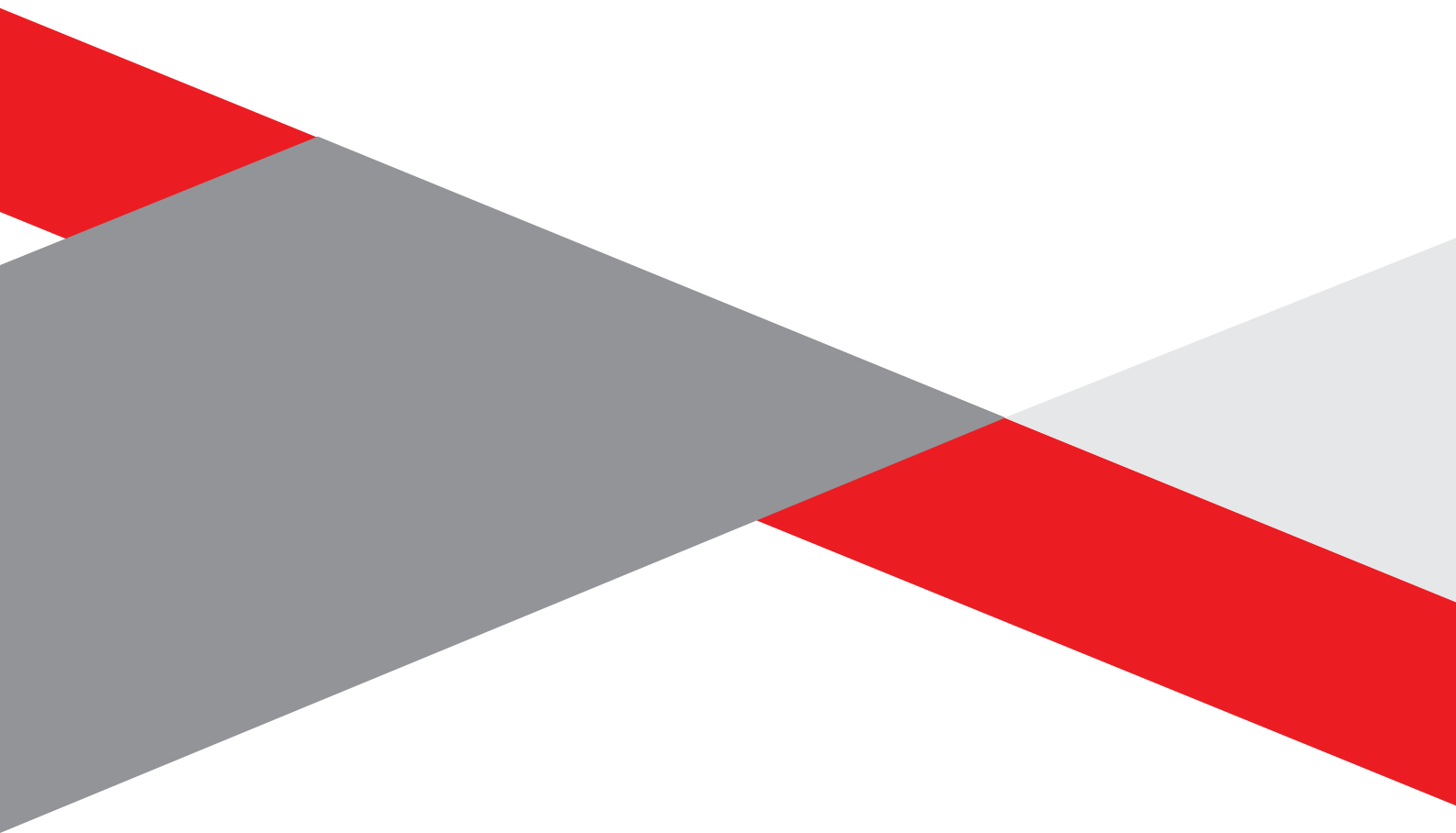

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESSES

DEVELOPMENT OF THE 100MW LICHTENBURG 1, 2 AND 3 PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE NEAR LICHTENBURG, WITHIN DITSOBOTLA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, NORTH-WEST PROVINCE

Applicants: ABO Wind Lichtenburg 1 PV (Pty) Ltd, ABO Wind Lichtenburg 2 PV (Pty) Ltd and ABO Wind Lichtenburg 3 PV (Pty) Ltd

Proposed Amendments: ABO Wind Lichtenburg 1 PV (Pty) Ltd, ABO Wind Lichtenburg 2 PV (Pty) Ltd and ABO Wind Lichtenburg 3 PV (Pty) Ltd received Environmental Authorisations (EA) for the development of Photovoltaic (PV) Solar Energy Facilities near Lichtenburg in the North-West Province. The projects are known as Lichtenburg 1 PV (DFFE Reference: 14/12/16/3/3/2/1091; issued 01 July 2019), Lichtenburg 2 PV (DFFE Reference: 14/12/16/3/3/2/1092; issued 02 July 2019) and Lichtenburg 3 PV (DFFE Reference: 14/12/16/3/3/2/1093; issued 03 July 2019). The Environmental Management Programmes (EMPr) were approved as part of the Environmental Authorisations.

The Lichtenburg 1 PV, 2 PV and 3 PV projects have been selected as Preferred Bidders and have executed Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs). The original Eskom Cost Estimate Letter (CEL) was for each project connecting separately. When considering the three projects together, Eskom has advised that:

- » The existing power line approved for Loop-In-Loop-Out (LILo) for each of the projects does not have sufficient capacity to connect the projects.
- » One power line to the existing Eskom Watershed Substation for all three projects from a central collector substation is preferred.

ABO Wind Lichtenburg 1 PV (Pty) Ltd, ABO Wind Lichtenburg 2 PV (Pty) Ltd and ABO Wind Lichtenburg 3 (Pty) Ltd have amended the Environmental Authorisations to allow for the revised grid connection approach (the amendments have been approved) and are now requesting the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) to amend the EMPrs approved as part of the Environmental Authorisations issued on 01 July 2019, 02 July 2019 and 03 July 2019 as follows, to be in line with the amended EAs received for the projects on 21 June 2022:

Amended EMPrs and Layouts Available for Public Review and Comment: Savannah Environmental has amended the Environmental Management Programmes and Layouts for the Lichtenburg 1 PV, 2 PV and 3 PV projects to be in line with the amendments outlined above. Boer rig glo vuurwapen op polisie by veiling

NOORDWESTER – LICHTENBURG – ‘n Boer van die Molopo-omgewing het vandeeweek in die hof verskyn nadat hy na bewering tydens ‘n veiling ‘n vuurwapen op polisiebeamptes gerig het.

Volgens Kol. Adèle Myburgh, polisiewoordvoerder, sê die Ngaka Modiri Molema-veediefstalstabiliserings taak span het Donderdag tydens ‘n veiling by Buhmansdrift naby Ottoshoop ‘n operasie uitgevoer ten einde vas te stel of die Wet op Diere-identifikasie nagekom word. Polisiebeamptes het Matthys Michiel Pienaar (35) glo op die veiling gevra oor vee wat na bewering nie gebrandmerk is nie. Volgens Myburgh het Pienaar aggressief geraak toe die beamptes hom uitvra oor die vyf beste wat moontlik nie gemerk was nie. Pienaar het glo sy vuurwapen op die polisiebeamptes gerig voordat

hy in sy voertuig by die veiling weg is.

Die polisiebeamptes het hom agternagesit, voorgekeer, ontwapen en in hegtenis geneem. Pienaar het Vrydag in die landdroshof in Molopo verskyn waar borgtog van R1000 aan hom toegestaan is. Hy word aangekla van die rig van ‘n vuurwapen, crimen injuria, intimidasie en verset teen inhegtenisneming. Hy moet weer in Augustus in die hof verskyn. Lt. genl. Sello Kwena, die provinsiale polisiekommissaris in Noordwes, waarsku dat geen vorm van intimidasie die polisie sal afskrik om hul verantwoordelikhede uit te voer nie.

Al hoe meer in duisternis gehul...

NOORDWESTER – LICHTENBURG – Alhoewel huishoudings en sakeondernemings in Suid-Afrika en ook in ons verspreidingsgebied reeds maniere moes vind om rondom die laer vlakke van beurtkrag te werk, vererger die negatiewe uitwerking op die ekonomie met elke bykomende fase.

Wie sal jou glo as jy jare terug voorspel het dat ons gebuk sou gaan onder fase ses beurtkrag en dat fase agt nie uitgesluit is nie?

Dan word daar deur kenners voorspel dat die stand van sake nie gaan verbeter nie en dat ons in ‘n stadium ‘n totale inkonking van die kragnetwerk kan ondervind wat tot twee weke sal neem om weer aan die gang te kom! Op die oomblik is die beurtkrag-nagmerrie op almal se lippe en bring dit vir ieder en elk groot skade, ongerief en frustrasie mee.

Beurtkrag veroorsaak dat substasies die gees gee wanneer krag gereeld aan- en afgeskakel word tydens beurtkrag en dit lei tot langer as beplande kragonderbrekings. Groot dele in ons gebied ervaar kabeldiefstal tydens beurtkrag en dan kom krag dooenevondig nie weer aan na beurtkrag nie en moet kables eers weer deur Eskom vervang word.

Dit hou groot ongerief en ook finansiële skade vir verbruikers in.

Volgens ‘n gemeenskapskoördineerder van Coligny, Marian Hendriks, is die totale ure wat Lichtenburg/Ventersdorp/Coligny en Bospoort sonder krag was in Mei 2022 is 68 ure, 44 minute en Junie 2022 - 253 ure en 12 minute! Groot hoeveelhede kables word deur kabeldiewe gesteel in mielielande wat dan Eskom se taak om die kables te vervang bemoelilik. Eskom sekerheidswagte is ook nie suksesvol om hierdie diewe vas te trek nie en vir gemeenskapslede wat nou self kraglyne patroleer is dit ‘n onbegonne taak om groot areas te fynkam en veilig te hou.

“Suid-Afrika se energiekrisis het ontaard in ‘n ekonomiese ramp. Suid-Afrikaners is nou vir oorlewing afhanklik van elektrisiteit wat nie beskikbaar is nie en vloeibare brandstof wat nie beskikbaar is nie,” sê dr. Wynand Boshoff, VF Plus se hoofwoordvoerder

oor minerale hulpbronne en energie. “Te midde van fase 6-beurtkrag het landsburgers ook die week gehoor dat petrol en diesel se prys weer skerp styg. Bykans alle petroleumprodukte sal voortaan meer as R25 per liter kos. Elke landsburger word deur beurtkrag geraak en duisende kragopwekkers word met petrol en diesel aangedryf,” sê hy. Die beurtkrag wat in hierdie stadium ingestel word, word bestempel as die ergste nóg. Opeenvolgende dae van fase 6-beurtkrag, met fase 4 wat snags en oor naweke geld – en ‘n terugkeer na fase 6 later deur die dag is veel erger as enige vorige beurtkrag wat Suid-Afrikaners vantevore moes verduur. Eskom het aangevoer dat die verhoogde fase veroorsaak is deur die onwettige staking by talle van sy aanlegte.

Die publiek word aangeraai om die Eskom Push app op hul selfone af te laai wat aandui wanneer beurtkrag in jou area sal plaasvind.

Relative arrested for toddler's murder

NOORDWESTER – LICHTENBURG – The Lichtenburg Police are investigating a case of murder after the body of two-year-old Neo Refemetswe Tlhome of Extension 3, Blydeville, outside Lichtenburg was found in a shallow grave on Tuesday (5 July).

According to the information received, police were called by Neo's mother after a suspicious grave near the river was spotted.

The grave was dug out and the decomposed body of young Neo was identified by the clothes that he was wearing on the day of his disappearance.

Neo went missing on 24 May 2022 while he was with his grandparents.

His disappearance was only established by his mother when she went to fetch him after work. Subsequent to the fruitless search by the community members and Neo's family, a missing person enquiry was opened for investigation. The police also joined the search, but Neo was never found.

According to Col. Willem Bekeer, station commander at Lichtenburg a 22-year-old relative was arrested on Wednesday at about 17:45 and will appear in court on Friday (8 July) on a charge of murder.
