



### Visitors Centre Windows





Windows show different levels of deterioration. One would require sandblasting for deep rust removal prior to finishing.

# Visitor Centre Waiting Room





Display cabinet to be moved to adjacent Wall.

Photographs to be removed and replaced by the display cabinet.



Flaking paint to be scrape & sanded down. The wall filled, primed & overpainted.

### Visitor Room Cubicles





10 false window screen fronts will be mounted in front of the existing window screens to house monitors and wiring The false window screens will simulate and be to the finish of the existing screens.

### Visitor Centre Cells





Cell doors to be sanded and/or ground down to remove rust, next primed and overpainted, cell interior walls to be restored as described in the supporting document.



Cell exterior walls to be sanded, filled, primed and overpainted.

### Dankie Hek 1





Dankie Hek 1 bars to be sanded/ ground down, rust removed, primed and over painted. Sections of the cross bars are badly rusted and would need to be ground off and replaced.

### **MSP Exterior**





The areas showing deterioration are the painted and varnished areas. The materials and method of restoration are described in the supporting document.





Step paint worn down and needs to be repainted. Step surrounds to be sanded down, primed and over-coated with enamel paint.

## Spine Corridor floor





The floor paint edging is worn and needs to be repainted. The old paint needs to be sanded down prior to painting The floor will be degreased and sanded down and resealed with an epoxy resin sealant.

The door is lying in the Hospital yard. The bullet hinge is broken and needs to welded, the rust removed, the door primed & painted.






ed rail is in good condition except for two areas of the rails that show some rusting. The rusted areas will be ground away and the metal treated with cold galvanising paint.
