DESTRUCTION PERMITS: Nos 80/11/10/009-010/51

We refer to the above destruction permit issued in respect of the property described as the Remainder of Farm Nuwe Kalkbult No.181, in the Philipstown District, Northern Cape Province. A copy of that permit is attached for ease of reference. The permit is valid until 1 December 2012. The permit application was brought by Mr. DRNM Morris on behalf of Scatec Solar. The applicant, Scatec Solar respectfully requests that the validity of the permit be extended by 12 months to 1 December 2013.

As you may recall the proposed use of the land is the establishment of a photo voltaic solar facility in response to the request for Proposals issued by the Department of Energy ('DoE') for Independent Power Producers to produce renewable energy. This renewable energy proposal submitted in respect of this property was awarded preferred bidder status in the first phase window. No work could commence on the site until all the conditions precedent had been met and financial close had been declared by the DoE in respect of all the phase 1 projects. This was declared on the 7 November 2012 and the site was finally approved for the development of the solar facility by the DoE. Scatec are now in a position to appoint engineers and developers and to proceed with the construction. It is anticipated that this will take approximately 2 months to commence, with the construction phase being about 8 months.
