- Mr. Mgidi indicated that his sister, who resides on a farm just outside Witbank, may have graves within the TOP area.

The PGS project team members visited the sister of Mr. Mgidi but she indicated that all her graves are located at Mazolomane as well.

During the remainder of the day some informal discussions took place with a number of potential family representatives. These individuals consulted with include:

- Ms. Leya Mahlangu who indicated that she had a grave on the farm Klipplaat.
- Ms. Nomvula Makara who indicated that she has graves at TOP25.
- Ms. Mokoena and Mr. Ogies were contacted and a meeting scheduled with them for the following Wednesday (14 March 2012).

Afterward, they visited the family of Ms. Sarah Zulu in Witbank. Her family indicated that all the families they still knew never buried anyone in what is known as the TOP area.

Activities:

Both Ms Ngati and Ms Mnguni were picked up from their homes and brought to the mine. They immediately indicated that their graves are located at TOP3. At this cemetery each family representative identified one grave. Ms. Ngati identified the grave of her son Joseph Nyati at TOP3/69 whereas Ms. Mnguni identified the grave of her daughter Nomthandaso Mnguni at TOP3/70.

A meeting was subsequently held at the Boschmansfontein Mine Offices during which the proposed relocation process was explained to the family members in both English and isiZulu. Both family representatives were very happy with the proposed relocation and signed the permission forms.

The family members were collected from their homes and taken to the mine. They were taken to TOP3 where Ms. Mlambo identified nine graves belonging to her family, namely TOP3/37, TOP3/38, TOP3/39, TOP3/40, TOP3/41, TOP3/45, TOP3/66, TOP3/67 and TOP3/68. Ms. Skosana identified seven graves of her family namely TOP3/19, TOP3/21, TOP3/22, TOP3/23, TOP3/29, TOP3/30 and TOP3/71.

A meeting was subsequently held at the Boschmansfontein Mine Offices during which the proposed relocation process was explained to the family members in both English and isiZulu. The family representatives were very happy with the proposed relocation and subsequently signed permission for their graves to be relocated.

Background:

After the name and contact details for Ms Lydia Phahlamhlaka was obtained the previous day, she was telephoned and a meeting arranged with her for the next day at her home in Hlalanikahle.

The purpose of the meeting:

The reason for the meeting was to establish whether Ms Lydia Phahlamhlaka knew of any of her family's graves located on Tweefontein farm and if so to provide her with an overview of the proposed relocation. It was also important to speak to her as one of the headstones from TOP3 had the name Phahlamhlaka written on it.

Discussion:

During the discussion the PGS representatives explained the purpose of our visit and we asked about the relation of Phahlamhlaka and the grave that we saw in TOP3. Lydia explained that the grave belonged to her sister's child and added that one of her uncles, Mr Ndlela also has graves in the same cemetery. The PGS representatives then drove to the collect her sister who lives in Vosman. They returned with the sister and a meeting took place with Lydia's sister, Ms Agnes Phahlamhlaka. The two sisters mentioned that their parents lie buried on the farm Klipplaat. A meetin was scheduled with the representatives of the Phahlamhlaka family for 3 April 2012. The two sisters then suggested that the PGS representatives visit their uncle, Mr Ndlela. At his house Mrs Sonto Gedrude Ndlela, the wife of Mr. Ndlela was met. She confirmed that they have graves of parents and one child at TOP3. She also mentioned that some of her other family members also have graves there.

Additional contacts:

The Phahlamhlaka sisters subsequently took the PGS representatives to a certain lady who knew the Mtsweni family who has graves in the same cemetery. She referred the PGS representatives to Ms. Nrambo Rachel Mtsweni who stays in KwaThema.

35. Meeting on 28 March 2012

Background:

As there was a strike at Phola on this day, it proved impossible for Mr Shorty McGina to leave the town safely. As a result Mr Vusi Khumalo decided to attempt to locate Ms. Nrambo Rachel Mtsweni at Kwa-Thema.

The purpose of the meeting:

The reason for the activity was to locate the Mtsweni family at Kwa-Thema.

Discussion:

While the address details provided earlier to the PGS representatives did not yield any results, Mr Khumalo managed to speak to Ms. Mabel Mabena who knew of the Mtsweni family but did not have any contact details for them. She then told Mr. Khumalo that there are people in Brakpan who might have contact details for the Mtsweni family. Mr. Khumalo then drove Ms. Mabena to Brakpan where the telephone number for an Mtsweni family member residing in Phola was obtained. The number was given through to Mr Mgcina who located the family in Phola. They confirmed that they have graves at TOP3 and a grave visit was scheduled with the family for 4 April 2012.

Discussion 1:

The PGS representatives started off with visiting Ms. Nyathi at her home in Witbank. The aim of the meeting was establish whether Ms. Nyathi (who had already signed for her graves located at Tweefontein) could not provide any additional information on other families of graves buried at Tweefontein. Ms. Nyathi indicated that the Ndlovu family of Phola buried some of their relatives at TOP3. Ms. Nyathi referred the PGS representatives to her sister Ms. Esther Mgidi, who also resided in Phola and may be able to assist in locating the Ndlovu family.

Discussion 2:

After leaving Ms. Nyathi's house the PGS representatives drove to Klipfontein to visit Ms Nhlumbane who had been referred to them. She referred the PGS team to Mrs Mthombeni of Clewer who according to her had graves buried at Tweefontein. Ms. Mthombeni indicated that she knew of three families who had graves buried at the farm, namely the Manyoni, Mthombeni and Mtsweni families. When asked if she could provide the PGS team with contact details, she indicated that they should return the following day.

Mr Mthombeni accompanied the PGS team to the residence of Mr. Nhlumbane, who indicated that although his family has graves in the area, they are located away from the study area.

Discussion 2:

After dropping Mr Mthombeni off, the PGS team travelled to Phola. They met Ms Esther Mgidi who indicated that she knew the Ndlovu family. However, due to prior commitments she was unable to take the PGS team to them and requested that they return the next week.

Discussion 3:

The third discussion of the day was with Mr. Jerry Mahlangu. He indicated that he was willing to identify the graves of their family, but only after the Easter holidays.

Discussion:

The Mtsweni family was taken to TOP3 where they identified three graves. These include two graves located directly adjacent (even almost under) the northern palisade fence and are both covered in soil accidentally discharged during grading operations of the adjacent haul road. The Mtsweni family subsequently signed the written permission forms. Their only request was for the three graves to be reburied in the Kameelrivier cemetery which is under the management of the local traditional leader. They agreed to obtain the permission for the three burials from the traditional leader.

Discussion 1:

The PGS representatives started off by visiting the Mtsweni family residing in Phola. They provided the telephone number for Ms. Nrambo Rachel Mtsweni who has one grave buried at TOP3. Ms Mtsweni was phoned and she immediately confirmed that her daughter lies buried at TOP3. The proposed relocation was explained to her and she expressed her thankfulness for the assistance provided by the mine and PGS for moving the grave of her child to a more accessible place. A meeting was scheduled with Ms Mtsweni for 25 April 2012 to visit the mine and cemetery. One of the Mtsweni family members present during the discussion indicated that he knew that the Ndlovu family also has graves buried at TOP3. The family member indicated that as far as he is aware the Ndlovu family resides at Albion.

Discussion 2:

The PGS team travelled to Albion to look for the Ndlovu family. After enquiries were made, they were informed that the Ndlovu family resides in Phola.

Discussion 3:

The PGS team travelled to Phola and visited the house of Ms Bidinga Ndlovu. She took the PGS team to her granddaughter Ms Anna Ndlovu, who confirmed that the grave of her son lies buried at TOP3. A

meeting was scheduled with Ms. Ndlovu for 25 April 2012 to visit the mine and cemetery. She then referred the fieldwork team to the Zwane and Masango families.

Discussion 4:

The PGS team travelled to the residence of the Zwane family where Mr John Zwane and Ms Flora Zwane were met. They confirmed that their child lies buried at TOP3 and also indicated that Ms Flora Zwane's uncle is also buried there. The proposed relocation process was explained to them, and they agreed to the process. A meeting was scheduled for 25 April 2012 to allow the family to visit the cemetery and grave.

Discussion 1:

On the previous day the Zwane family told the PGS representatives that a Magagula family residing in Albion also had graves at TOP3. The team travelled to Albion and after some enquiries were made were informed that the Magagula family did once reside at Albion but has since moved away. The team were sent to Mr Shabangu who have been in the area most of his life. Mr Shabangu, who happened to have been a family representative on a previous project, indicated that he does not know where the Magagula family have moved to but expected that a daughter of the family by the name of Magagula resides in Witbank. The team travelled to Witbank but was unable to locate Ms Poppy Magagula.

Discussion 2:

On the way back from Witbank the PGS team visited Ms Esther Mgidi at Clewer to enquire about the whereabouts of the Mnguni family. Ms Mgidi referred the team to her sister in Phola who knows the Mnguni family well.

Discussion 3:

The PGS team located the sister of Ms Mgidi who directed them to the Mnguni family. Mr Tana John Mnguni was met and he indicated that his father's oldest brother lies buried at TOP19. He was not willing to provide permission for the relocation of the grave as he was not a child of the deceased. He directed the PGS team to a Mr Sindane of Clewer who knew some of the other Mnguni family members. At Clewer the PGS team was directed to members of the Mnguni family residing in Hlalanikahle.

Discussion 4:

The PGS team travelled to Hlalanikahle and met Ms Joana Mashiane, a cousin to Mr Tana Mnguni. She indicated that there might be more graves of the Mnguni family at the cemetery.

Discussion 3:

The PGS team visited Clewer to try and identify members of the Magagula family, but without success.

From Ackerville the PGS team travelled to Hlalanikahle to collect Ms Joana Mashiane. They then took her to her cousin Mr Tana John Mnguni at Phola. During the meeting it was concluded that Mr Mnguni will sign for the Mnguni graves at TOP19. A meeting was scheduled with Mr Mnguni and Ms Mashiane for 25 April 2012 to allow them to visit the mine and graves.

While Ms Mlambo knew of a few families, she did not have any information on the current whereabouts of these families.

Discussion 2:

The PGS team then travelled to Clewer to meet with Ms Esther Mgidi and her sister. They told the PGS team of the Mpande and Ntini families who used to reside on Tweefontein, but indicated that as far as they were aware these families had since moved to the Delmas area.

Discussion 3:

The PGS team travelled to Vosman to meet with Ms Nyati. She was not able to provide the names of other families who used to reside at Tweefontein.

Unfortunately, the municipality's computer system was down and a staff member there recommended that the PGS team should visit the old age home. The team visited the home and were welcomed by the elders residing there. The PGS team presented the aim of their visit but nobody knew the Mpande or Ntini families.

On this day an email was received from Mr. William de Jager, who indicated that he is the grandson of Christiaan Lodewikus de Jager who lies buried at TOP 21. A family friend had seen the newspaper notice that was published in Beeld on 24 April 2012.
