NOTIFICATION OF THE INTENDED RELOCATION OF HUMAN REMAINS – ANGLO AMERICAN PLATINUM, DER BROCHEN PROJECT

PROJECT INFORMATION

This communication serves to inform you that our company has been appointed by Anglo American Platinum, to effect the relocation of approximately 3 graves affected by mining activities. The graves are located in three informal cemeteries/areas spread across the farm listed below. We will be assisted on this project by Martins Funeral Undertakers. The public consultation process, to identify next of kin for the graves, commenced in 2014 and the project is envisaged to be concluded by early 2018.

Please be advised that according to the health regulations (published in May 2013), a member of the SAPS must be on site during the exhumation of the remains. We will be in contact with your office to discuss the logistics of this.

LOCATION OF THE GRAVES

The graves, affected by the expansion of mining activities of the Anglo Platinum der Brochen Project, are located on the following properties that falls under your jurisdiction:
