We wish to consult with the land owner and other affected parties in respect of the application this Company has made for a prospecting right over the aforementioned property. This letter and its attachments provide background information and it would be appreciated if you would please take the time to look through this material and respond as requested below. This communication is the start of the consultation process as required by law, which will continue throughout the application process and for the duration of any prospecting right, should such be granted to us. It is thus vital that you confirm your correct contact details for future communication.

On 2 September 2014, De Beers Consolidated Mines Proprietary Limited ("De Beers") lodged an application for a prospecting right for diamonds, in terms of Section 16(2) of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, No. 28 of 2002 ("the Act"), in respect of the aforementioned property. De Beers has received acceptance of the application on 8 September 2014 from the Department of Mineral Resources.

Application has also been made for permission in terms of Section 20(2) of the Act to remove and dispose of such bulk samples of any potentially diamond -bearing minerals found by De Beers in the course of prospecting operations conducted pursuant on any prospecting right issued in favour of De Beers.

It must be stressed that the application is for a prospecting right and NOT for mining

As is required by Section 16(4) of the Act, you are hereby notified of the Company's application and are invited to comment on the proposed prospecting operation, as part of the consultation process described above. Such comments are incorporated in the Environmental Management Plan (EMPlan) for this property, which must be compiled and submitted to government for approval. In this regard, it would be appreciated if you could complete the attached form to confirm your contact details and so that any specific issues can be identified and addressed. In this way negative impacts on the property and the environment in general can be kept to a minimum. This form should then be returned to this office at the address below, preferably by fax or e-mail, by 26 November 2014 if possible.

Any comments can also be referred to the Regional Manager, Department of Minerals Resources, (Free State Region), Private Bag X33, WELKOM, 9460, (The STRIP Building 314, Cnr Stateway and Bok Street, WELKOM, 9459). In terms of Section 16(4) comments in this regard are required to be lodged with the Regional Manager by 26 November 2014. Please include the reference number for this application FS 30/5/1/1/2/10312 PR.
