

- (b) SUBJECT to the following special conditions created in said Deed of Transfer No. 1591/1915, namely:
 - 1. A brick or stone building to the value of at least R500,00 per Lot and R300,00 for any subdivision shall be erected within two years from the date of sale (viz: 26th October, 1912) and rates will be levied on those amounts added to the value of the land in the third and each succeeding year until the buildings are erected when rates will be levied on the value of such buildings not less than the foregoing amounts and this clause shall be the Contract or Agreement within the meaning of Section 7 of Ordinance 11, 1911.
 - 2. No dwelling house will be permitted to be erected on an area less than 929 square metres and the lot, if subdivided will only be capable of subdivision into two equal parts.
