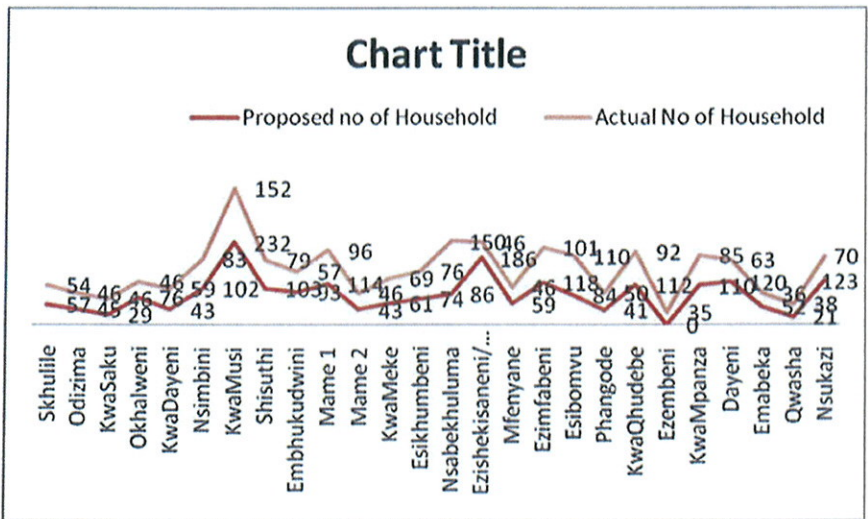

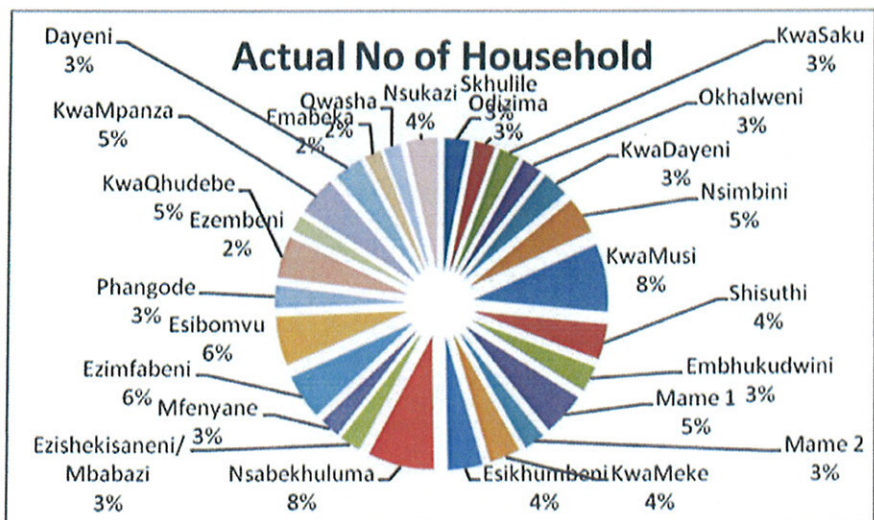
The following table gives us a comparison from proposed and actual households and it also give us the current number of people in the proposed project area.

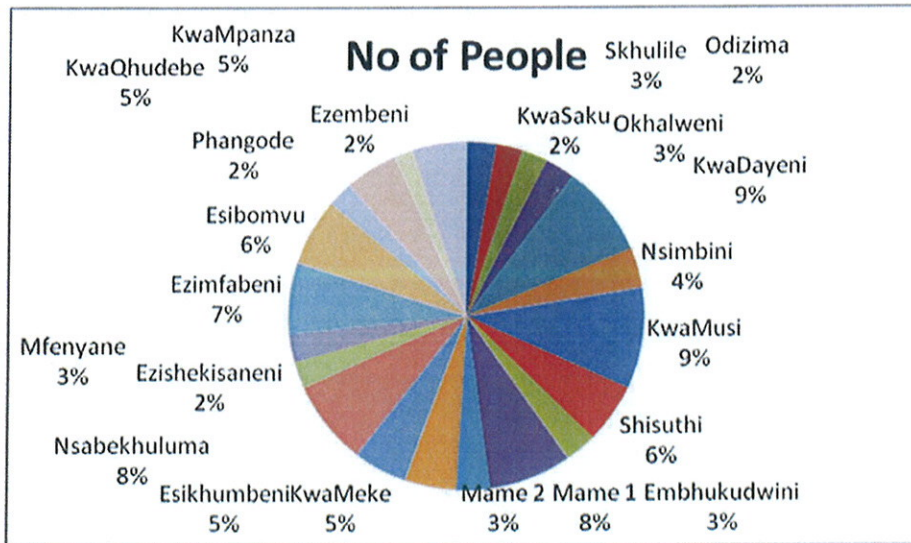
This table reveals that the proposed household has dropped from 2184 to 1821 households .The following graph shows us how the number of households have dropped.

It would be interesting to note that in terms of this study the number of household and number of people per village is directly proportional. The following diagram illustrate this.



The leadership is impressed with the maps and allocation. Few household have been added in the household and indicated on the maps.

The main concern of the leadership has been the exclusion of two villages:

- Onyanga
- Izingqunyane
