**NOTIFICATION OF ISSUANCE OF A WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECT:  
DECOMMISSIONING OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PRETORIA'S ONDERSTEPSPOORT INCINERATOR

This letter serves to inform you, as a registered Interested and Affected Party (I&AP), that the National Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (the Department) has decided to grant the University of Pretoria (the Applicant) with a Waste Management Licence for their project entitled the "Decommissioning of the University of Pretoria's Onderstepoort Incinerator" and its associated activities. The Department has issued the Waste Management Licence in terms of Section 49 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008), as amended. The Department's decision was signed on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 and issued to the Applicant via email on the 25<sup>th</sup> of September 2021. Annexure 1 of the Waste Management Licence is attached to this letter. A copy of the Waste Management Licence will be provided upon request from the EAP or Applicant.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 4 December 2014, as amended, the applicant must, in writing and within 14 days of the date of the decision on the Waste Management Licence application, ensure that all registered I&APs are provided with access to the decision and the reasons for such decision; and that the attention of all registered I&APs is drawn to the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of the National Appeal Regulations, 2014. EARTHnSKY Environmental (Pty) Ltd is facilitating this process on behalf of the applicant.

In terms of Chapter 2 of the National Appeal Regulations, 2014, an appeal may be lodged against the decision by the Department to grant a Waste Management Licence. An appellant must submit the appeal submission (the Appeal Questionnaire and Appeal and Response Form) to the Appeal Administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant (the University of Pretoria), any registered I&AP and any organ of state with interest in the matter within **20 days** from the date that the notification of the decision for an application for a Waste Management Licence was sent to the registered I&APs by the applicant (via the EAP).

An appeal submission must be submitted **in writing** in the form of the Appeal Questionnaire (Appendix A of Annexure 1 attached to this letter) and accompanied by-

- (i) a statement setting out the grounds of appeal;
- (ii) supporting documentation which is referred to in the appeal submission; and
- (iii) a statement, including supporting documentation, by the appellant to confirm compliance with regulation 4(1) of the National Appeal Regulations.
