

NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION, WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE AND WATER USE LICENCE

IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A MINING RIGHT AND MINING PERMITS FOR THE WEST WITS PROJECT GAUTENG PROVINCE

West Wits Mining MLI (Proprietary) Limited (West Wits) intends to apply for a mining right and mining permits in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (MPRDA) (No. 28 of 2002) for gold, uranium, silver, sandstone and aggregate over their current prospecting right area (GP 30/5/11/2/10035 PR). Consent in terms of Section 11(2) of the MPRDA to cede a renewed prospecting right MPT No. 29/2016 from Mintails SA Soweto Cluster (Proprietary) Limited to West Wits was granted by the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) in 2018.

The West Wits ('the project') Mining Right Application will include a Mining Work Programme as well as a Social and Labour Plan in addition to the integrated Environmental Authorisation application. Mining would involve the removal of low grade gold bearing material that would be accessed via a combination of opencast mining and refurbishing of existing infrastructure to access the existing underground workings. Additional opencast pits would be excavated on various portions of the above mentioned farms, and excess material crushed and trucked off of site. The gold bearing material would be processed at plants off-site. Once the removal of economic material has been completed the sites will be rehabilitated. The post closure land use will be identified during the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process and the land could be suitable for housing or agriculture purposes. The project would also include the establishment of additional supporting infrastructure such as material storage areas (product, topsoil, waste rock, fuel, lubricants, process materials, waste and hazardous substances), water management infrastructure, communication and lighting facilities, offices, workshops, washbays, stores, change houses, lamprooms, vent fans and security facilities.

Further details as well as background to the company and application process will be presented to stakeholders at the public scoping meetings as shown in the table below.

TER STAWING VAN 'N AANSOEK OM 'N MYNREG EN MYNBOUTERMITTE VIR DIE WEST WITS PROJIEK GAUTENGPROVINSIE

West Wits Mining MLI (Eiendoms) Beperk (West Wits) is van voorneme om aansoek te doen om 'n mynreg en mynboutermitte ingevolge die Wet op die Ontwikkeling van Minerale en Petroleum Hulpbronne (MPRDA) (Wet 28 van 2002) vir goud, uraan, silwer, sandsteen en aggragaat oor hul huidige prospektergebied (GP 30/5/11/2/10035 PR). Toestemming ingevolge Artikel 11(2) van die MPRDA om 'n hernude prospekterreg (MPT No. 29/2016) van Mintails SA Soweto Cluster (Eiendoms) Beperk aan West Wits te seeder, is in 2018 toegestaan deur die Departement van Minerale Hulpbronne (DMH).

Die West Wits ('die projek') Aansoek om Mynreg sal 'n Mynbouwerkprogram, asook 'n Maatskaplike- en Arbeidsplan insluit, benewens die geïntegreerde aansoek om Omgewingsmagtiging. Mynbou sal die verwydering van laegraadse gouddraende stof behels waartoe toegang verkry sal word deur 'n kombinasie van dagmynbou en die opknapping van bestaande infrastruktuur om toegang tot bestaande ondergrondse delfplekke te verkry.
