NOTICE OF BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd received EA for the Zonnequa Wind Farm (DEA.Ref.No.: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1971) also on 18 February 2019. The approved wind farm is located within the Springbok Renewable Energy Development Zone (REDZ), approximately 20 km south-east of the town of Kleinsee in the Northern Cape. In order for the wind farm to evacuate the generated power into the national grid the wind farm requires the development of a grid connection solution.

This letter serves to inform you that a Basic Assessment processes is being undertaken for the grid connection solution associated with the wind farm. The infrastructure associated with the grid connection solution will include the construction of a double-circuit 132kV power line, a collector substation and associated infrastructure including access tracks/roads, administrative buildings and laydown areas.

The following two connection options exist within the 300m corridor for each grid connection solution, namely:

- » A direct connection from the Strandveld Substation to the existing Gromis Substation located ~18km from the northern boundary of the Zonnequa Wind Farm project site. This is considered to be the preferred option from a technical perspective due to the fact that the Gromis Substation is already existing.
- » A loop-in loop-out connection from the Strandveld Substation to the proposed Rooivlei-Gromis 132kV double-circuit power line which forms part of the Namas Wind Farm grid connection solution. The proposed Rooivlei-Gromis 132kV double circuit power line is located ~800m to the east of the Strandveld substation. This option is only viable should the Namas Wind Farm be developed.

BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The development (i.e. construction and operation) of the grid connection infrastructure is subject to the requirements of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014 published in terms of Section 24(5) of NEMA. In terms of the EIA Regulations of 2014 (as amended on 07 April 2017) promulgated under Sections 24 and 24D of the NEMA, various aspects of the project are listed as activities that may have a detrimental impact on the environment. The main listed activity triggered by the proposed grid connection infrastructure is Activity 11(i) of Listing Notice 1 (GNR327 of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended)), which relates to the development of facilities or infrastructure for the transmission and distribution of electricity outside urban areas or industrial complexes with a capacity of more than 33 but less than 275 kilovolts.

Due to the triggering of Activity 11(i) of Listing Notice 1, of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), a Basic Assessment process must be undertaken in order to obtain Environmental Authorisation for the construction and operation of the grid connection solution for the Zonnequa Wind Farm. The 300m corridor is also located within the northern corridor of the Strategic Transmission Corridors and the Springbok Renewable Energy Development Zone (REDZ), gazetted on 16 February 2018 (GNR113 and GNR114). This transmission corridor is considered to be of strategic importance for the rollout of the supporting large-scale electricity transmission and distribution infrastructure in terms of Strategic Integrated Project 10: Electricity Transmission and Distribution.

Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd appointed Savannah Environmental, as the independent environmental consultant, to undertake a Basic Assessment for the project to identify and assess all potential environmental impacts associated with the grid connection solution and recommend appropriate mitigation measures in an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr).

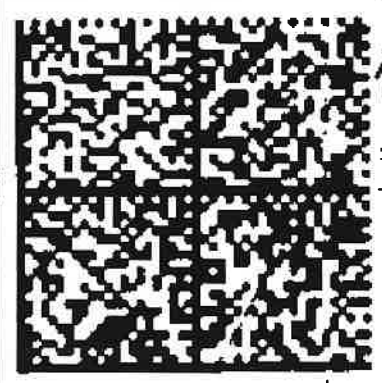

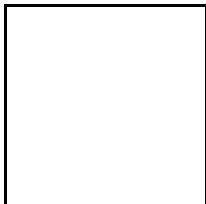
