APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION (DEA Ref.: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1970)

Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd received an Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the construction of the Zonnequa Wind Farm and associated infrastructure in the Northern Cape Province (DEA ref: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1970) on the 18th of February 2019.

Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd is applying for the amendment of the turbine specifications and facility layout as included in the EA dated 18 February 2019 as follows:

Component	Approved	Proposed amendment
Number of turbines	Up to 56	Up to 35
Hub height	Up to 130m	Up to 150m
Tip height	Up to 205m	Up to 240m
Turbine capacity	Up to 4.5MW	Up to 7MW

The overall generation capacity of the wind farm will remain 140MW.

The proposed amendments in themselves are not listed activities and do not trigger any new listed activity as the proposed amendments are within the original authorised development footprint and do not change the scope of the EA issued.

In terms of Condition 5 of the Environmental Authorisation dated 18 February 2019 and Regulation 31 of the EIA Regulations of December 2014, as amended, it is possible for an applicant to apply, in writing, to the competent authority for a change or deviation from the project description to be Savannah Environmental has prepared a Motivation Report in support of this amendment application on behalf of Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd.

The Motivation Report is available for a 30-day review and comment period from **Wednesday**, **09 October 2019** to **Friday**, **08 November 2019**. The Motivation Report can be downloaded from Savannah Environmental's website (https://www.savannahsa.com/public-documents/energy-generation/zonnequa-wind-farm/). The due date for written comment is **Friday**, **08 November 2019**.

All comments received will be included in the final Motivation Report which will be submitted to the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries (DEFF) (previously the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA)) for review and decision-making.

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
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
