Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd received an Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the construction of the Zonnequa Wind Farm and associated infrastructure in the Northern Cape Province (DEA ref: 14/12/16/3/3/1/1970) on the 18th of February 2019.

Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd is applying for the amendment of the turbine specifications and facility layout as included in the EA dated 18 February 2019 as follows:

The overall generation capacity of the wind farm will remain 140MW.

The proposed amendments in themselves are not listed activities and do not trigger any new listed activity as the proposed amendments are within the original authorised development footprint and do not change the scope of the EA issued.

In terms of Condition 5 of the Environmental Authorisation dated 18 February 2019 and Regulation 31 of the EIA Regulations of December 2014, as amended, it is possible for an applicant to apply, in writing, to the competent authority for a change or deviation from the project description to be approved. Savannah Environmental has prepared a Motivation Report in support of this amendment application on behalf of Genesis Zonnequa Wind (Pty) Ltd.
