APPLICATION FOR PROSPECTING RIGHT IN TERMS OF SECTION 16 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, ACT 28 OF 2002 (THE ACT) AS AMENDED BY SECTION 12 OF THE MINERAL AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACT, ACT 49 OF 2008 "HEREIN REFERRED TO AS THE AMENDED ACT": A PORTION OF PORTION 28 OF THE FARM GROOTFONTEIN 165 IR; IN THE MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT OF NIGEL.

- This is to inform you that your application for a prospecting right for Coal in terms of Section 16 of the MPRDA, (as amended) has been accepted.
- 2. In terms of section 12(d) read with regulation 52(1) of the said Act, you are therefore required to:
- a) Consult in the prescribed manner with the landowners, lawful occupiers and any other interested and affected party and include the result of the consultation in the relevant environmental reports.

3. Apply for a Water Use Licence at the Department of Water Affairs and Sanitation in

accordance with the National Water Act and associated Regulations, where applicable.

4. The Minister has, after having had regard to and considered the type of mineral that you

applied for and the extent of your proposed prospecting activity decided to direct you to

give effect to the objects of section 2(d) of the MPRDA. You are therefore directed to

submit the following documents within 60 days [i.e. on or before the 15 \ 11 \2018 ] from

the date of this letter, namely;

a. Duly signed shareholders agreements with your empowerment partner in which

provision shall be made for entrepreneurs, local community and employees,

b. Share certificates,

c. Details relating to the equity by the BEE shareholders,

d. Any other agreement relating to the BEE shareholding including the voting pool

agreement, where applicable, and

e. Your Articles and Memorandum of association.

5. Acceptance of your application does not grant you the right to commence with any

prospecting and/or mining activities. It only signifies that your application will be

processed in order for the Minister or his delegate to consider same and make a decision

within 197 days from the date of acceptance of your application.

You are furthermore requested to consult with Newshelf 1186 (Pty) Ltd also as your interested

and affected party due to the fact that they have an existing prospecting right over your area of

interest for the same minerals. Proof of such consulation must be incorporated in your

environmental report(s)
