INTRODUCTION

Turquoise Moon Trading 157 (Pty) Ltd (Turquoise Moon) has mining and exploration-related interests in the Limpopo Province. Turquoise Moon is a South African holding company which is 74% owned by Ferrum Crescent Limited (listed on the Australian Stock Exchange and currently listing on the London Stock Exchange). The prospects cover two areas, referred to as the Moonlight and De Loskop areas, respectively. The regional setting of these areas is shown in Figure 1. PROJECT OVERVIEW – MOONLIGHT

Mining and iron making operations

Overview

The project will involve opencast mining, a mineral processing plant, mine-residue disposal facilities and associated supporting services and facilities.

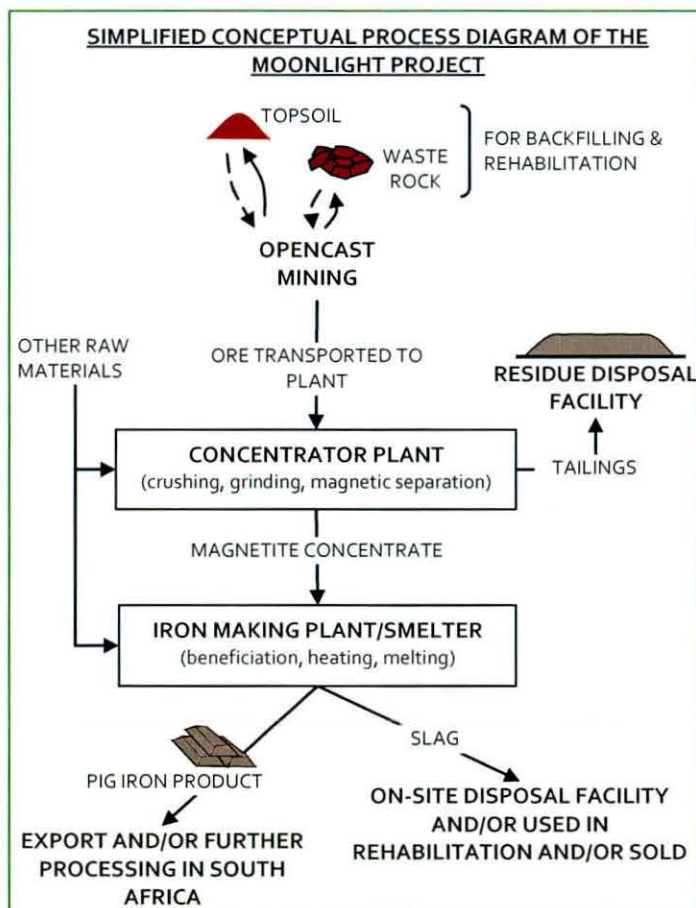
Opencast mining

The resource to be mined is the iron mineralisation within the Banded Iron Formations. It is planned to mine the ore body using conventional open pit methods. Topsoil and overburden stripped during the mining operations will be used in the rehabilitation process.

Iron making operations

Mined ore will be processed on site to produce a pig iron product for export purposes. Approximately 1 million tonnes of pig iron will be produced per annum. Mine residues produced by the project will include tailings and slag. Management of these wastes could be through disposal on an on-site engineered residue disposal facility, re-use in rehabilitation or sold (slag only).

An overview of the proposed production process is below.



Further information on the project and alternatives considered will be given at the information sharing meetings.

SERVICES

Water will be one of the main raw materials used in the process. The availability and use of water for the project will be carefully looked at during the project planning.

Power supply will be sourced in consultation with Eskom. Alternative supplies including on-site generation will be considered.

Domestic and industrial waste generated by the project will be collected and handled on site, temporarily stored in designated areas and disposed of at permitted waste disposal sites. Sewage will be treated in a sewage treatment facility to be erected on site.

Transport of materials to and from site will be by road. Changes to the existing road network may be required. Within the site boundaries, haul roads, conveyors, pipelines and rail will be used.

STAFF AND HOUSING

Approximately 100 temporary construction jobs and 720 operational phase jobs.

At this stage it can be assumed that the mine will be operational 24 hours a day and 7 days a week.

Housing of staff will be addressed in the EIA and could include the establishment of a mine village in the area.

SUPPORT FACILITIES

Other facilities required on site include:

- * material storage and handling areas (coal, ore, fuel, lubricants, process materials, gas, hazardous substances, explosives);
- * water management (clean / dirty water dams, clean / dirty storm water controls);
- * a helipad and airstrip;
- * communication and lighting facilities; and
- * offices, change houses, ablutions, security facilities.

TIMING

Decision on the feasibility of the project to be taken by Turquoise Moon in 2nd half 2011.

If approved, construction will commence in 1st half of 2012 with mining and processing activities reaching full production in 2016.

Planned life of mine – about 30 years

ALTERNATIVES BEING CONSIDERED

The process of considering alternatives is ongoing and will form part of the scoping and EIA/EMP phases of the environmental assessment process. Alternatives will be considered for the proposed project footprint, mineral processing technologies, water and power supply, transport mechanisms, mine residue disposal.

PROJECT OVERVIEW – DE LOSKOP

Exploration activities

Activities at De Loskop will include the drilling of core holes and possibly trenching. The minerals that will be targeted include iron ore, manganese, limestone, marble and nickel. Drilling will take place using a truck-mounted drill rig. No mine waste will be generated. All material recovered will be sent for analysis.

MOTIVATION FOR THE EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES
