

Co-ordinates of heritage sites

The field survey was undertaken in July 2012. Table 1 lists these sites while Figure 7 shows their location. Archaeological visibility was good as the grasses were short due to winter. Eight heritage sites were recorded.

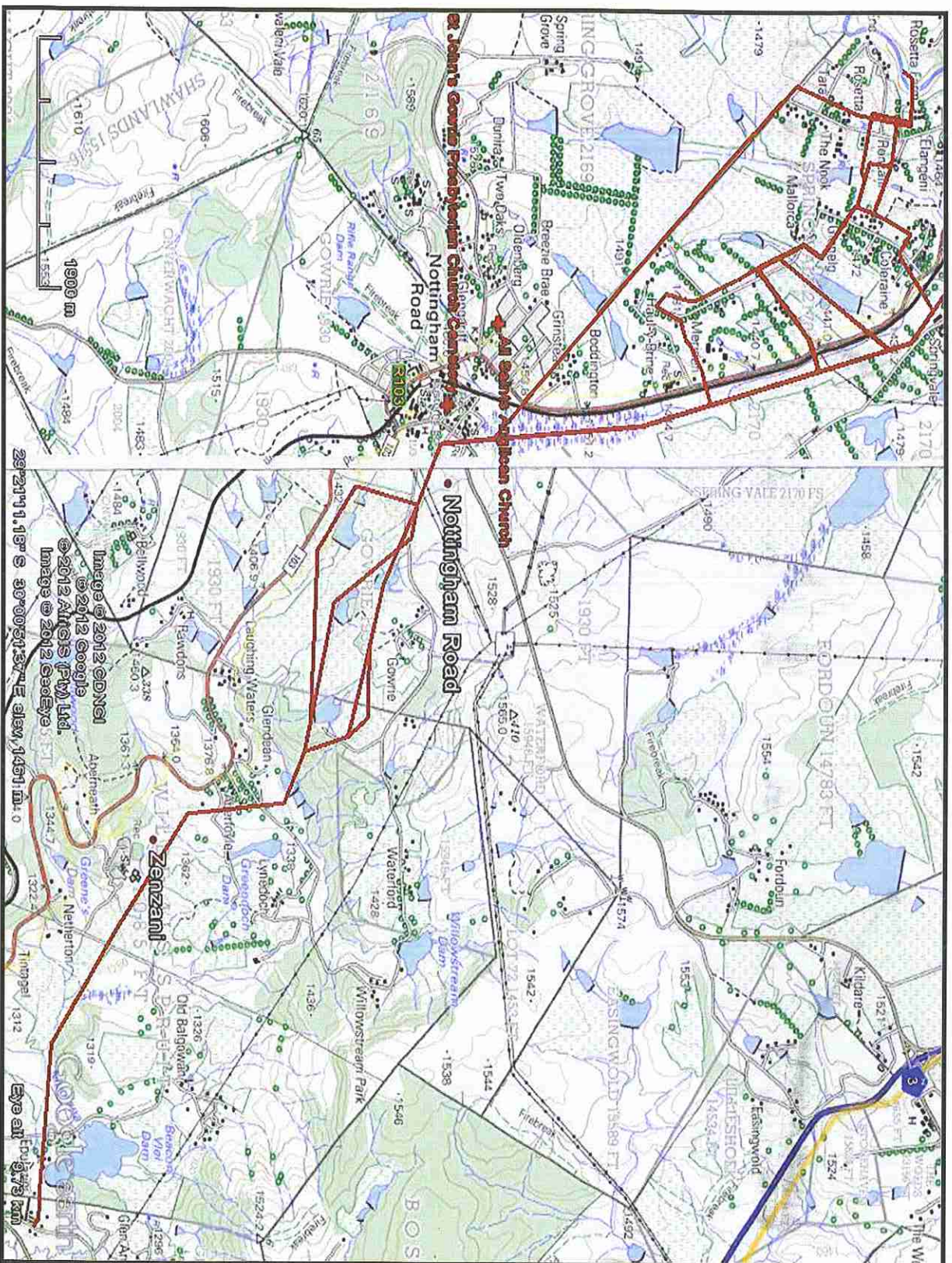


Figure 3-2: Topographical map of the northern section of the proposed
