Since the repair and maintenance of the existing Slipway will not increase the harbour footprint, the MUCH Unit at SAHRA is pleased to approve the aforementioned permit application. The following terms and conditions apply:

- 1. If the permit holder is not present on the site at all times, the heritage authority must be provided with the names and contact details of her authorised representative(s).
- 2. This permit gives the holder and/or her authorised representative(s) the sole right to work on the site of the Arniston Harbour Slipway for the duration of the permit period.
- 3. Work must be limited to rehabilitation of the existing Slipway using the methods outlined in the description of works attached to the permit application. All activities undertaken under the authority of this permit must be for the sole purpose of infrastructure upgrades to the Slipway only.
