I attach as requested a permit for the exhumation, analysis and reburial of human remains that may be unearthed during excavation and construction activities of new sewer lines, in the Newtown area, Newtown (Old) Cemetery, Grahamstown, Eastern Cape. The SAHRA APM Unit has noted that any human remains unearthed during the installation of sewer pipes will be removed and stored at the OD Inggs Funeral Home until reburial. As there may be a possibility of uncovering War graves as well, it has been noted that should these be identified, discussions will be undertaken with military historians to memorialize this event. In addition, the Parks and Recreation Board will set aside a portion of land for the re-burial of the human remains from the Newtown (Old) Cemetery, in the Makana Municipal Graveyard.
