I attach as requested permits to allow for the exhumation of possible Victims of Conflict (as noted in the attached permits), from Mmabatho cemetery (Mafikeng, North West Province), Huhudi cemetery (Vryburg, North West Province), Tshikota cemetery (Limpopo Province) and Thohoyandou cemetery (Limpopo Province). These permits also serve as export permits should this be necessary.

Permits for Lekasi cemetery (Nelspruit, Mpumalanga Province) and Avalon Cemetery (Soweto, Gauteng Province) (80/06/05/020-021/81) have been approved and will be issued as soon as we have details of permit holders.

SAHRA understands that this process is a continuation of exhumations conducted on behalf of the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) through its Priority Crimes Litigation Unit (PCLU) as part of its mandate outlined by the Truth and Reconciliation Committee.

SAHRA understands this will once again be a collaborative effort and wishes you well with this endeavor.
