I attach as requested a permit to undertake trial excavations to determine the presence of graves (older than 60 years) at 34 Prestwich Street, Green Point. As this location falls within the 'Core Burial Area' in Green Point, the protocol as agreed between SAHRA, the City and HWC will apply. This means that whilst SAHRA manages the permit applications in terms of burials under section 36, HWC has reviewed the application in terms of its cultural material (section 35).

Any graves uncovered during the test excavations should be reported to SAHRA and the activities on site must be halted to obtain a further permit to allow for the processes as indicated in the regulations pertaining to burial grounds and graves. SAHRA understands that any human remains uncovered during the trial excavation will be temporarily stored at the University of Cape Town. However the remains will be reinterred once a final resting place has been identified and the memorialisation process put in place for all the remains that have come from the Green Point Burial area.
