Application for the export of three books for sale

In accordance with Section 3 and Section 32 of the National Heritage Resources Act No. 25 of 1999, (NHRA) and the gazetted List of Types (2002/12/06) in terms of section 32(5)(b)(i), the objects listed below do not satisfy the requirements for being considered part of the national estate of South Africa and therefore do not require an export permit in terms of Section 32(19) of the Act. For an object to be considered as a heritage object it must have been in the country for a period of fifty (50) years or more or must make special reference to (and hold cultural significance for), communities or individuals within South Africa.

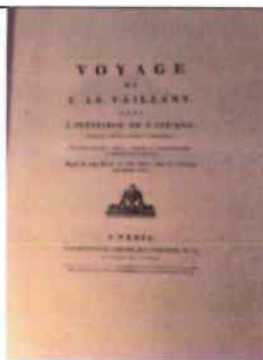

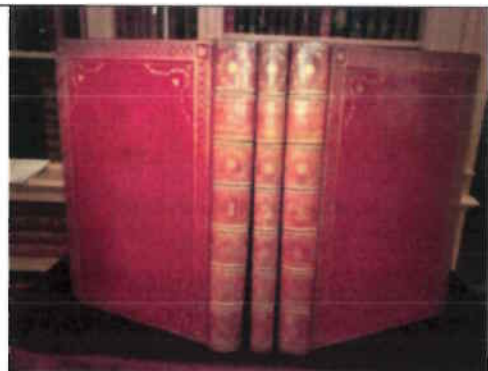
