In terms of Section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Attention: Sunshine Mineral Reserves Pty Ltd

Sunshine Mineral Reserves (Pty) Ltd (hereafter referred to as Sunshine) holds an executed Prospecting Right (FS 30/5/1/1/2/10445 PR) and the associated granted Environmental Authorisation (FS 30/5/1/1/3/2/1/10445 EM). The Prospecting Right was executed by the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) Free State Regional Office in 2017 and is valid for a period of 5 years ending in 2022.
