Permit Application for the Phase 2 Archaeological Mitigation for the site DUB004 at the Agrizone 2 Development, Dube Trade Port, Development Close to King Shaka International Airport in the Province of Kwazulu Natal

The Heritage Officers Committee meeting considered the permit application on 06 April 2022. The committee noted that the application is related to a permit obtained for the destruction of sites DUB001 and DUB002 (case id:17306) for further expansion of the Agrizone 2, Dube Trade Port development.

Attention is drawn to the proposed activities of this specific application as the applicant would need to obtain permits for other activities. For the transportation of samples to a PGS laboratory at Pretoria, a temporary export permit would need to be obtained in terms of Section 40(8) of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute Act No. 05 of 2018 (form G).

Furthermore, a permit for the collection of samples/artifacts, if any retrieved, will need to be obtained in terms of Section 40(4) of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute Act No. 05 of 2018 (form E).

The Heritage Officers Committee has given approval for the proposed Ground Penetrating Radar survey and the proposed excavations of a minimum of 3 excavation squares. The case officer will issue a permit for **bringing equipment on-site** and conducting **excavations**. There are conditions attached to that permit that the applicant must adhere to.

The case officer must be notified of all reports uploaded to SAHRIS.
