The Heritage Officers Committee meeting considered your application on the 21 September 2022. The committee noted that the proposed development is in a green field area and is used as a natural grazing zone. However, some of the photographs provided shows a sandy area surrounded by rocks which is not clear what that indicates or may be indicating.

You are required to do a heritage impact assessment (HIA). The HIA must entails:

1. Identification of all heritage resources in the development area and its surroundings approximately 50m.

2. Assessment of the impact of the development on such heritage.

3. Evaluation of the impact of the development on heritage resources relative to the sustainable social and economic benefits to be derived from the development.

4. Results of consultation with communities affected by the proposed development and other interested and affected parties regarding the impact of the development on heritage resources.

5. Consideration of alternatives if heritage resources are affected by the development Mitigation plans for any adverse effects during and after completion of the project.

6. Table of all heritage resources identified. This should show the Heritage resource type, description, location, significance, and reasons for this rating.

Written responses/requests for reconsideration of the application or consideration of new information must be loaded to the case on Sahris.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u> from the date of this letter or the application will lapse and a new application will be required.
