We acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to carry out work on the above property. The KZN Amafa and Research Institute (the Institute) reviewed the application on the 29 July 2022.

Please be advised as follows:-

(1) The Institute was unable to consider the merits of the application as the work had already commenced, alternatively, has been completed;

(2) As a result, a permit cannot now be issued;

(3) We would like to draw your attention to the fact that your failure to obtain a permit prior¬ to the commencement of the work, is in contravention of the provisions of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute Act (5 of 2018), and as such is a criminal offence for which you may be prosecuted;

(4) However, the Institute has decided to condone your failure to obtain a permit, as required, on condition that the work was conducted strictly in accordance with **T.L. (STRUXIT PROJECTS)**

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drawing no.: 2017_0192_001-S-4000-1, 2017_0192_001-S-4000-2, received by the Institute on 29 July 2022, and that all the work shown on the application is completed within a calendar year of the date of this letter.

- (6) Prior written approval from the Institute is required for any deviation to the approved plans.
- (7) No legal action will be instituted against you in this instance.
- (8) 10 meters buffer zone from the structure is required
