The permit application in respect of the above, received on the 06 September 2022 reviewed by the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute (The Institute) on the 14 September 2022 and 16 November 2022.

Please be advised as follows:

The Committee noted photographs of the contextual urban setting had been received. However the streetscape consists of predominantly Marseilles tiled roofs and the proposed flat roof will disrupt that streetscape.

The Committee requires that the immediate neighbours be consulted in a public participation exercise. Detailed internal photographs of the main building must also be provided so that the committee can determine whether there are heritage elements that will be affected by the alterations.

The architect must provide coloured drawings e.g. plans, elevations, and sections to show the new work from existing.

The Architect must also provide a 3D rendition of the proposed building within the context of the surrounding buildings/streetscape so that the impact of the proposed alterations on the heritage streetscape can be determined.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u>from the date of this letter or the application will lapse and a new application will be required.
