The permit application in respect of the above, received on the 3 November 2022 reviewed by the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute (The Institute) on the 16 November 2022.

Please be advised as follows:

The committee noted that work has commenced on site without an Amafa approval. An affidavit which underlines the reasons for undertaking work without a prior Amafa approval is required e.g. why has work commenced, when was it done. A Separate Form I application with a fee of R4000 is required.

Public Participation: the applicant will be notified of the level of public participation required and will have to bear the costs thereof. Neighbours, Ward Councillors, and Heritage Societies should be consulted in the case of demolition & development applications. Owners & residents of properties within 100m must be consulted for demolition applications. All documentation submitted is retained for record purposes and interested and affected parties may apply to view the documentation.

Written responses/requests for reconsideration of the application or consideration of new information must be loaded to the case on Sahris (email khanyi.zondi@amafainstitute.org.za) within 30 days of the date of this letter or any requirements/decisions contained herein will be considered final. Extensions of this time frame can be requested upon receipt of motivation.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u> from the date of this letter or the application will lapse and a new application will be required.
