## **Interim Comment**

The proposal consists of removing the existing high pitched roof and replacing it with a much lower pitch using a traditional 22,5 degree pitched roof trusses and re-using the same Marseilles tiles. The only other alternative to this would be to demolish the dangerous part of the building. At present the building is deteriorating at a rapid rate if not attended to soon it will collapse.

The permit application in respect of the above, received on the 13 March 2023 reviewed by the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute (The Institute) on the 23 March 2023 refers.

Please be advised as follows:

- A Visual Impact Assessment report and a rendition of the impact on the nave were required.
- Internal photographs of the ground floor of the church, coloured in drawings showing all new work is required
- Front elevations to also be submitted.

Written responses/requests for reconsideration of the application or consideration of new information must be loaded to the case on Sahris (email <a href="mailto:khanyi.zondi@amafainstitute.org.za">khanyi.zondi@amafainstitute.org.za</a>) within 30 days of the date of this letter or any requirements/decisions contained herein will be considered final. Extensions of this time frame can be requested upon receipt of motivation.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u> from the date of this letter or the application will lapse and a new application will be required.
