Site Clearance of Umzinto SAPS erf 123 and 124 Umzinto, KwaZulu Natal

The permit application in respect of the above, received on the 08 February 2023 reviewed by the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute (The Institute) on the 14 February 2023.

Please be advised as follows:

- It was noted that the information in the scoping assessment was insufficient to allow the Heritage Officers' Committee to assess the heritage value. A full Heritage Impact Assessment is required.
- The HIA would largely cover the architectural resources but should establish whether there may be a possibility of graves or fossils on the site.
- Form A for all existing buildings that are over 60 years to be impacted on either through demolition or alteration must be submitted.
- A sketch plan showing all the impacts was required.

Written responses/requests for reconsideration of the application or consideration of new information must be loaded to the case on Sahris (email <u>khanyi.zondi@amafainstitute.org.za</u>) within <u>30 days</u> of the date of this letter or any requirements/decisions contained herein will be considered final. Extensions of this time frame can be requested upon receipt of motivation.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u> from the date of this letter or the application will lapse, and a new application will be required.
