DISCUSSION

Amongst other things, the following was discussed:

• The committee noted that on the photographs which had been required from the applicant there had been work done which had raised concerns if there had been previously approved plans to the council or to the Institute (KZN Amafa &R.I.).

Further requirements

• The committee require previously approved plans e.g., all plans which had been done on the previous years and were submitted to the council or to the Institute (KZNARI) for an approval, failure to provide required items a separate form I application with a fee of R4000 and accompanied with drawings is required.

Public Participation: the applicant will be notified of the level of public participation required and will

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have to bear the costs thereof. Neighbours, Ward Councillors, and Heritage Societies should be consulted in the case of demolition & development applications. Owners & residents of properties within 100m must be consulted for demolition applications. All documentation submitted is retained for record purposes and interested and affected parties may apply to view the documentation.

Written responses/requests for reconsideration of the application or consideration of new information must be loaded to the case on Sahris (email <u>khanyi.zondi@amafainstitute.org.za</u>) within <u>30 days</u> of the date of this letter or any requirements/decisions contained herein will be considered final. Extensions of this time frame can be requested upon receipt of motivation.

Required additional information or revised drawings must be submitted within <u>six months</u> from the date of this letter or the application will lapse and a new application will be required.
