UNAUTHORISED ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS: Portion 3 of Erf 791 Lot 0116 Duikerfontein - 56 Pine Grove, Parkhill, Durban North.

We acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to carry out work on the above property. The KZN Amafa and Research Institute (the Institute) reviewed the application on 1 March 2023. Additional documentation were reviewed on 2 August 2023.

Please be advised as follows: -

- (1) The Institute was unable to consider the merits of the application as the work had already commenced, alternatively, has been completed;
- (2) As a result, a permit cannot now be issued;
- (3) We would like to draw your attention to the fact that your failure to obtain a permit prior to the commencement of the work, is in contravention of the provisions of the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute Act (5 of 2018), and as such is a criminal offence for which you may be prosecuted;
- (4) However, the Institute has decided to condone your failure to obtain a permit, as required, on condition that the work was conducted strictly in accordance with **drawing number 1523-21**; **dated 14-12-2022**; **drawn by S.G (Kaye & Kaye Architectural Consultants)**, **received by the Institute on 15 February 2023**, **the property was graded Not Conservation Worthy** and that all the work shown

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on the application is completed within a calendar year of the date of this letter.

- Prior written approval from the Institute is required for any deviation to the approved plans. (5)
- (6)No legal action will be instituted against you in this instance.
