# UNLAWFUL ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS TO EXISTING BUILDING FOR NEW RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION TO 40 CLARK ROAD, BULWER, DURBAN, KWA ZULU-NATAL, 4001 DRAWING NUMBER 655919/1&2

It was noted that the required photographs had not been uploaded to the case.

There was no statement on the heritage value of the buildings and the impact of the development had on their heritage conservation worthiness.

The consultant had claimed that the municipality had given him to understand that the building plans had been approved less than 60 years earlier but the plans referred to were not uploaded to the case. The affidavit from the professional did not include his assessment of the age of the building gleaned from many years working in this area.

The Committee required:

- 1. Previously approved plans
- 2. Photographs of the buildings prior to the initial alteration referenced in this application
- 3. A heritage statement on the significance of the two buildings page two of the form was not adequately completed.
- 4. A revised statement from the professional consultant that details why the consultant believed the buildings to have dated from as late as 1965, given his extensive knowledge of the buildings of the area.
