The case was tabled and the HOC-meeting's members wanted the applicant to clarify when the internal changes took place with reference to the stairway, taken into consideration that the plan of 2011, drawn by Joan Camp did not indicate whether the stairs was already moved internally, while the changed position of the stairs are visible on the plans drawn by Sharon Keuter on 31 Jan 2011.

The owner must submit documents to prove that the stairs were already changed before 2006, otherwise the building was older than 60 years and the changing of the stairs internally would be illegal work.
