The proposal is for the demolition of the existing house and redevelopment of 36 dwelling units on the property at 652 Musgrave Road, Durban.

Discussion:

- The committee noted that the site had been inspected on 24 July 2023.
- The committee noted the buildings features were still intact and the external features were more significant than the internal features.
- The committee queried the motivation for the demolition: it was noted that the building was situated in the center of the site and development around the building would not be feasible. There was not a strong enough motivation from a heritage point of view.
- The committee proposed a grading of Grade IIIb for the building.
- The committee required a revised proposal that retained the house within the development.

Further requirements

• It was noted that, should the applicant wish to revise the replacement proposal, drawings showing minimal intervention on the house should be submitted.
